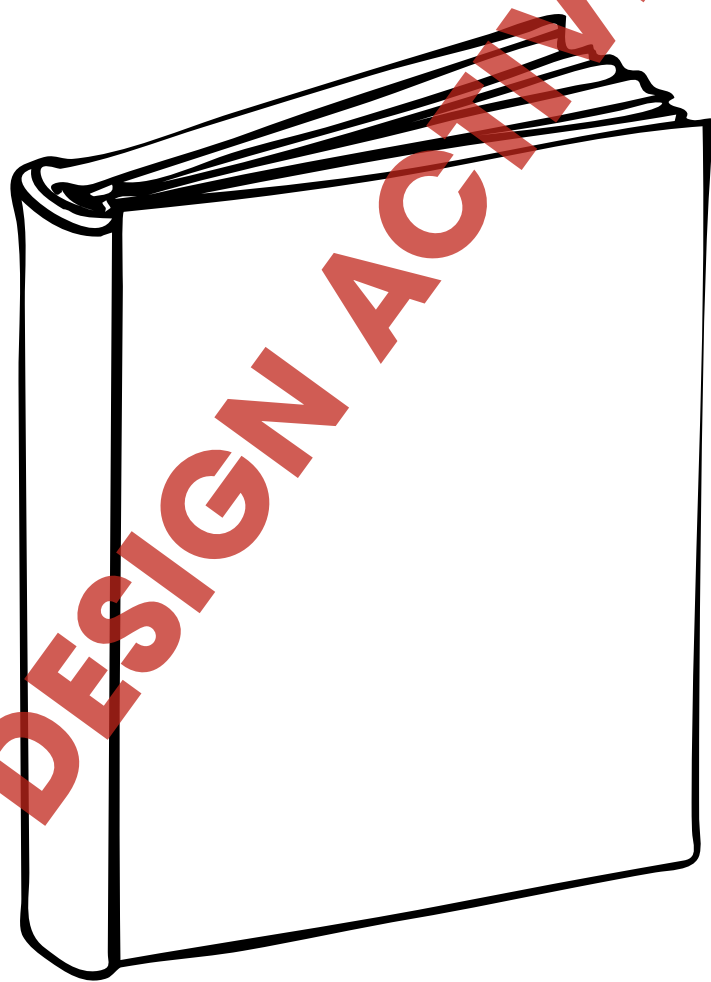


Activity Three
