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


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

North America's relative location is in the Western **Hemisphere**, north of the Equator. North America is east of Europe, west of Asia, and north of South America. Several oceans surround North America. To the north lies the Arctic Ocean, the Pacific Ocean to the west, and the Atlantic Ocean to the edst. These oceans provide **links** between North America and the other continents



North America's location gives it many different **climates**. In its most northerly point, in the Canadian territory of Nunavut, the temperatures rarely go above  $32^{\circ}$  F (0° C). In its most southerly point, in the country of Panama, the climate is that of a tropical rainforest! And in between these two extremes, a wide variety of different climates can be found.
