




4. Use the graphic organizer on page 36 to brainstorm fun things to do to avoid boredom.

# **Personal Safety**

Everyone should be safe at home. It is easy to make sure things are working. This will keep you and your home safe. Things like fire or carbon monoxide can be deadly. Make sure you have smoke detectors installed. Carbon monoxide detectors should be on every floor. Help keep your things safe when you are out. Do this by locking your doors and windows. Based on this scenario, is Seo-yeon being safe? Write a scenario of your own. Show safe and unsafe habits.







