A transgender boy truly feels as if he is a boy in the wrong body. A tomboy is a girl who expresses herself in a masculine way.







As soon as babies are born, they are given a gender by the doctor. If the baby has male body parts, then the parents are told that the baby is a boy. If the baby has female body parts, then the parents are told the baby is a girl. This is known as a person's **birth gender**. It is decided by their **biological sex**.

Key Term: Gender assignment is when the doctor tells you the baby's birth gender.

Babies are too young to have a feeling of what their gender identity is. Therefore, they are treated as the gender they were given at birth. The way they are treated is often based on beliefs of what boys and girls should be like.

A small percent of the population is born with body parts that are not fully male or female. These people are known as intersex.

Birth gender and gender identity are not the same thing! Birth gender is given at birth and gender identity is felt.

Babies often grow up and identify with their birth gender. For example, a baby is told that she is 'female' at birth. She will often grow up feeling as if she is a woman. Her birth gender is the same as her gender identity. When a person's birth gender matches their gender identity, they are known as cisgender.

Note: Cis is pronounced as "siss"-gender.

Being cisgender is seen as 'normal'. Most people think that a baby will grow up and continue to identify with the gender they were given at birth. Sometimes this does not happen.




