Revision is the third step in the writing process. In it, you reread your paragraph and decide if the information is presented in the most understandable way. After you have made any changes or revisions, it is now time to proofread, or look for mistakes in your writing. When you proofread your work, you are reading it to find and correct any errors you've made. **Proofreading** is the fourth step in the writing process.

The first steps in proofreading are to:

- 1. Read your paragraph aloud again.
- 2. Examine your paragraph look at the length, supporting sentence(s), and topic sentence.
