








# Number the steps from 1 to 5 in the order they occur in the book report writing process.



- 5 Writing the first draft of the report.
- 2 Choosing a book to read.
- 3 Making notes as you read the book.
- 4 Organizing your ideas before you begin to write.
- 1 (a) Talking to others about the kinds of books they like to read.



- Read the entire book! Don't skim
  the pages and don't pretend that
  you read something that you didn't.
- Use a graphic organizer to help you organize your ideas before you begin to write. Using graphic organizers as you prepare your book report will help you identify the main concepts in your book. A graphic organizer lets you describe characters, order events, and highlight plot action.
