The Holiday Surprise

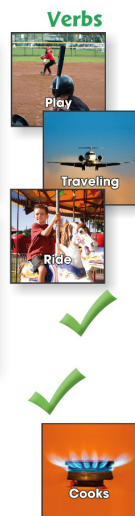
