Remember: with a Fishbone Map, the spine represents the main idea and the ribs represent the supporting details.

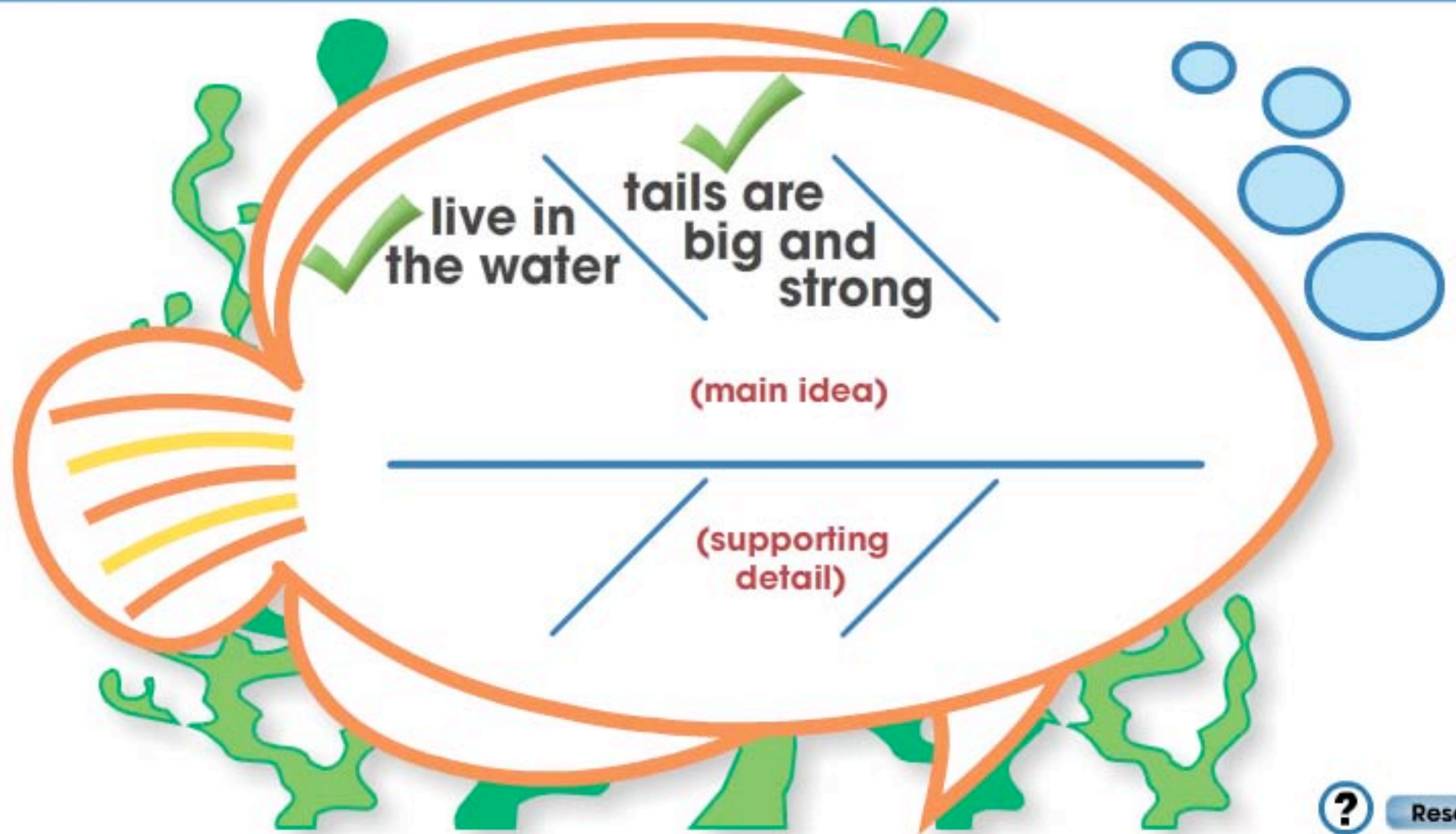

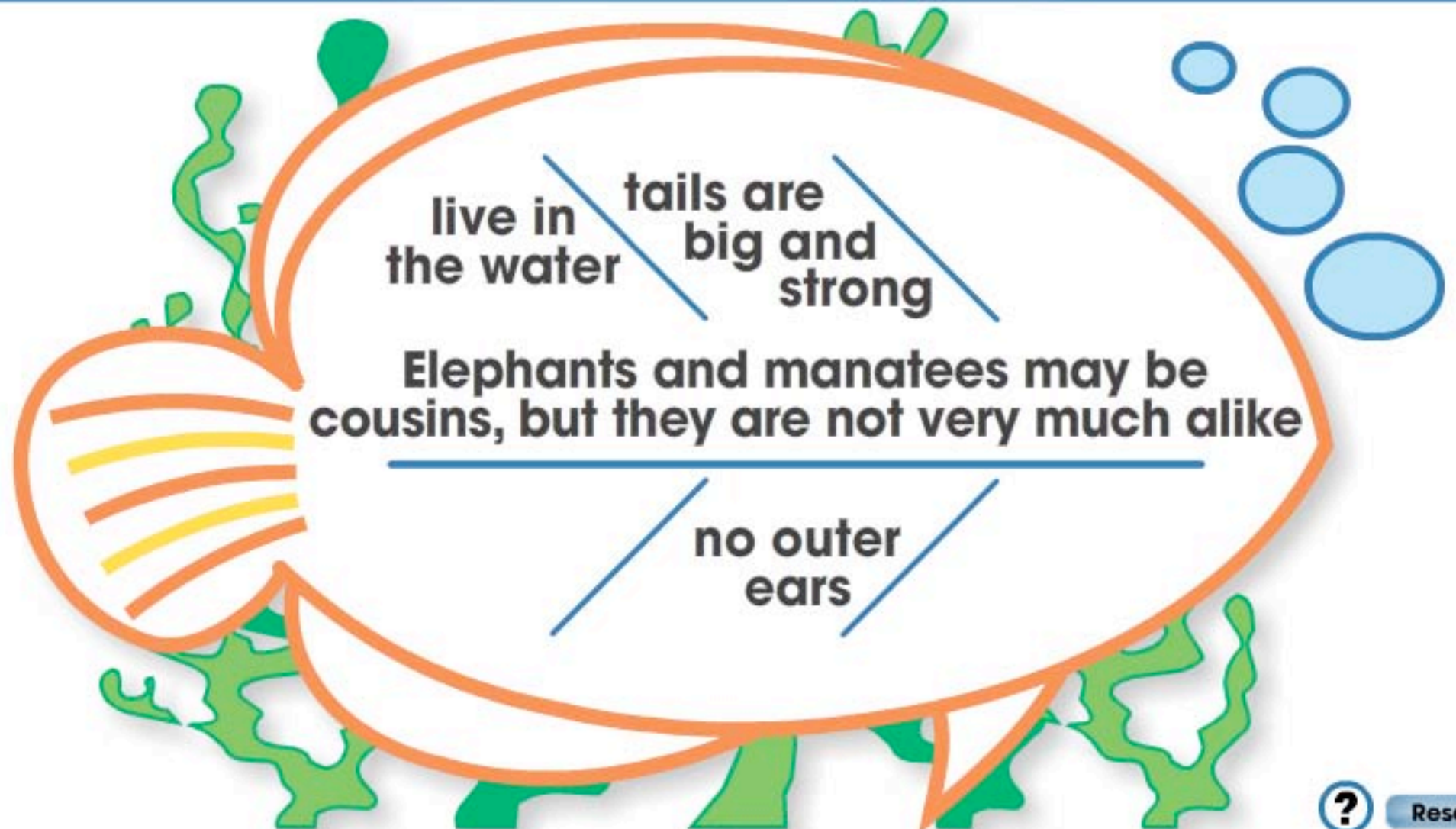
