





**Place Value** is the value a digit is given based on its placement in a number. Working from right to left, the first digit in a number is the "ones" value; the second digit in a number is the "tens" value; and the third digit in a number is the "hundreds" value.

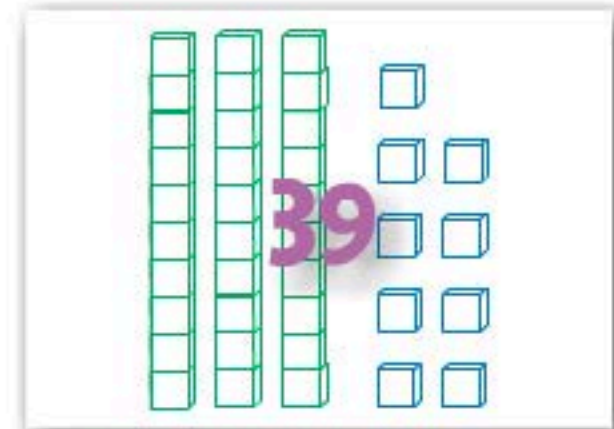
