


The Nervous System - Brain

One of the most important organ systems in our body is the nervous system. The nervous system is a network of tissue that has the job of sending and carrying messages to all areas of our body. Our nervous system controls all our movements and reactions to the world around



us. The nervous system is made of three important parts — the brain, spinal cord and nerves.

To understand how the parts of the nervous system works together, think of a computer system. The brain is the main computer. The spinal cord is the cable carrying the messages or **data** to and from the computer. All the nerves connect to the spinal cord. These nerves carry the **continue reading**

Parts of the Brain

Cerebellum

Important for movement, balance, and posture.

Spinal Cord

Passes the messages from the brain to the body through the nerves.

Cerebrum

Controls thinking, memory, all our emotions, and language.

Brain Stem

Controls involuntary movements like our breathing and heart beat.
