




## **Newton Crater**

Newton Crater is a large crater measuring 186 miles (300 km) in diameter. It was formed 3 billion years ago and lies South of the Equator. In 2011, images captured by NASA's Mars Reconnaissance Orbiter found possible water flows during the warmest months on Mars. Long, dark streaks appear in the Summer, and disappear in the Winter. In August 2011, scientists announced the likelihood of seasonal streams of liquid saltwater.
