Greenhouse Gases: Synthetic Gases

Synthetic gases are gases made by humans. They are not normally found in nature. The synthetic greenhouse gases that have the greatest effect on global warming are chlorofluorocarbons, or CFCs. CFCs were created in 1928. They were used for many purposes, such as refrigeration, aerosol cans, and cleansers.



In 1986, scientists discovered that CFCs were breaking down the ozone layer in the stratosphere. The ozone layer is important because it stops some harmful radiation from the Sun from reaching Earth's surface. People feared that the hole in the ozone layer would lead to a rise in skin continue reading.
