

Many places are now passing laws to encourage new buildings to be "green." Green buildings are designed with the goals of lowering greenhouse gas emissions, using less toxic materials, and reducing waste. Green buildings can lower greenhouse gas emissions in several ways.



Remember that the manufacture of products results in a lot of greenhouse gas emissions. Green buildings use more recycled products, such as carpets made from recycled fibers and wood reclaimed from older buildings. Green buildings may also favor products from industries that have made progress in reducing greenhouse gas emissions.
