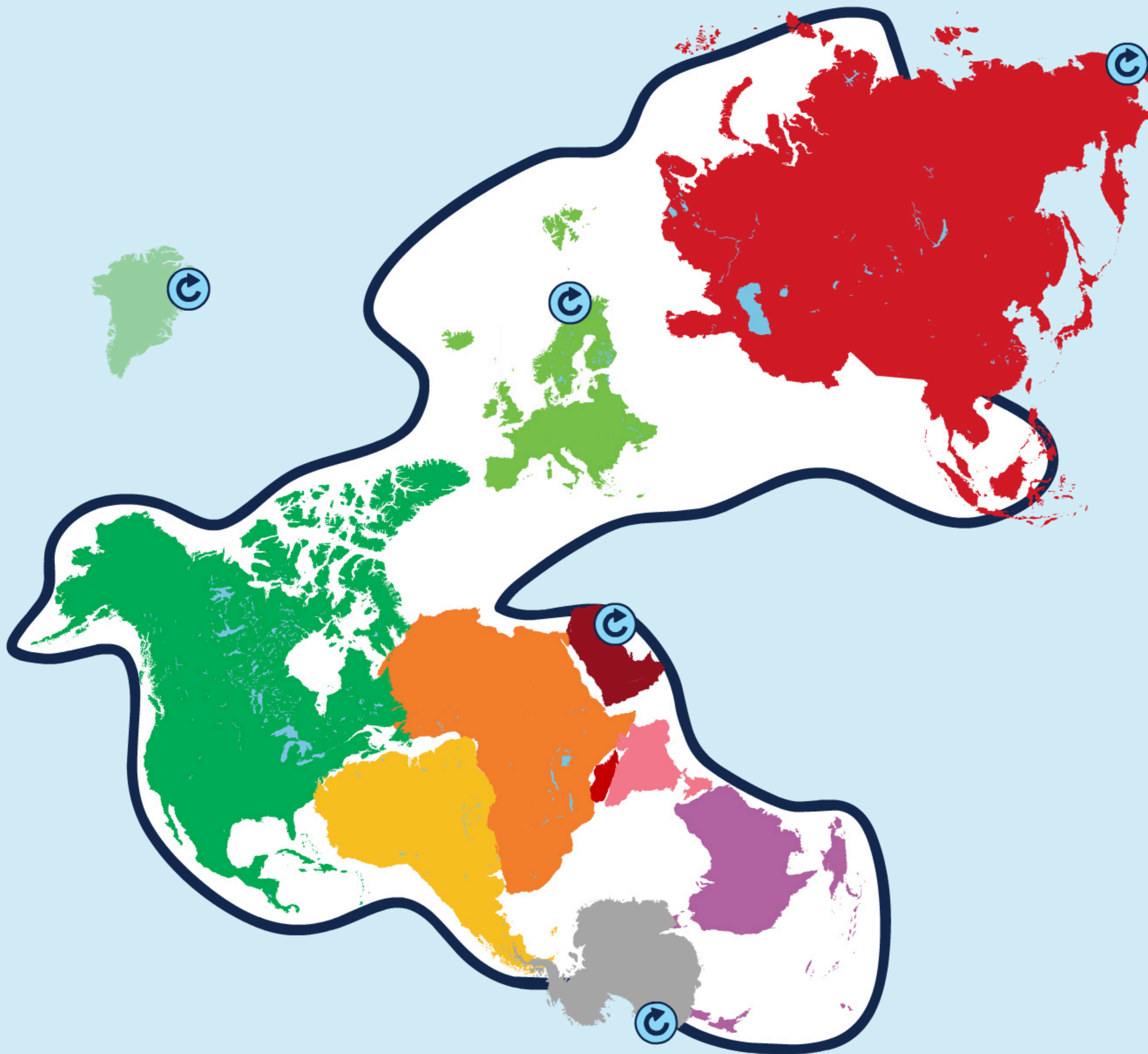

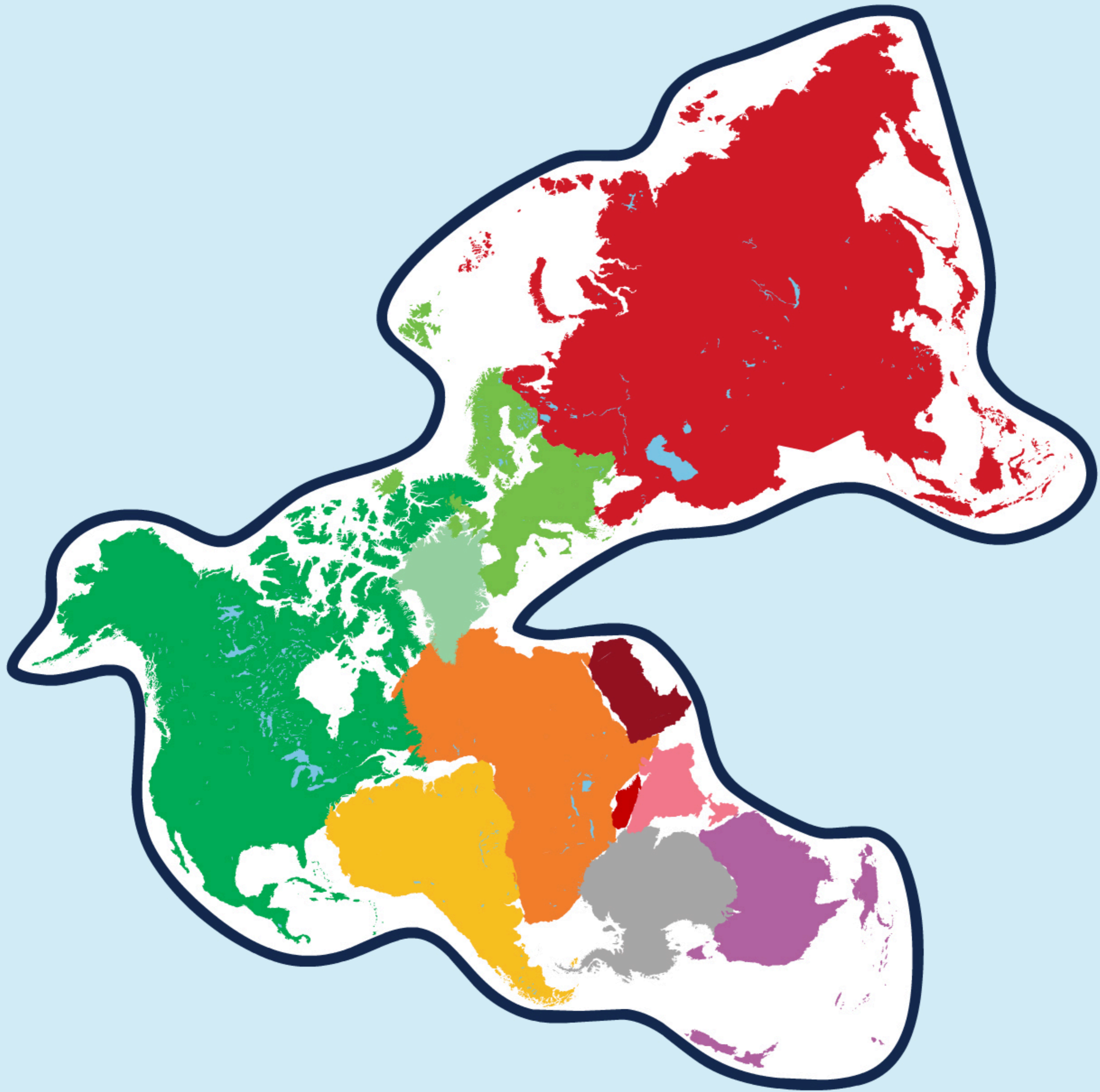
The Continental Drift Theory - Jigsaw Puzzle
