CONCEPT MAP

Miranda leads quite an eventful life, and during the course of events described in this novel, she experiences a wide range of emotions. Certainly many of her adventures make for fascinating reading and discussion. The **Concept Map** is an excellent tool to help students analyze story elements so they might better relate to a major event described in the novel. Students are asked to choose one major event (for example, Sal being saved by the laughing man) and provide details regarding the Five W's: WHAT happened, WHO was there, WHEN it happened, WHERE it happened, and WHY it happened.
