

Human/Environment Interactions

veryday, the things that people do affect their **environment**. Sometimes we build a **dam** on a river to control it more effectively. Sometimes we harm the habitats of animals with pollution. Sometimes we hunt animals to extinction. When an environment is harsh or changing, people must often adapt to their environment to survive. Learning about these issues is known as the study of human/environment **interactions**.



Unfortunately, not all interactions between humans and their environment are positive. Throughout parts of Southeast Asia, tigers are facing extinction because of **poaching**. Poachers collect tiger skins, bones, and other organs to be sold illegally for large amounts of money. The tiger's jungle habitat is also under threat from pollution and expanding human activities. While many organizations exist to help these endangered animals, many governments in Asia have been slow to stop this poaching. With only several thousand tigers left in the wild, the day may come when we will only see these majestic creatures in a zoo or a book.




