Departments of the Executive Branch of Government

s you have already learned, there are three branches of the M government: **executive**, **legislative**, **and judicial**. The executive branch has the important job of making sure that the laws of the country are obeyed. Remember that the president is the head of the executive branch. This branch is very large because many people are needed to help the president, and there are many jobs to do.

The president names the people who will help him run the country. These people are called **Secretaries of State**. Each Secretary of State is in charge of a specific area, or department, of the executive branch of government. Each department has an important job to help run the country well. For example, one department looks after Mexico's health care. Another department looks after communication and transportation. A third department is in charge of tourism. The executive branch is divided into many different departments; Let's look at five of them to find out what each one does.



Why is the executive branch of government divided into different departments?

Department of Health

People who work in this department make sure that Mexican citizens have the medical care they need. They run special activities and programs to help Mexicans stay healthy, and get the medicines they need if they are sick. Some of these workers also do research on diseases and medicines to help fight them.










Crossword Puzzle!
