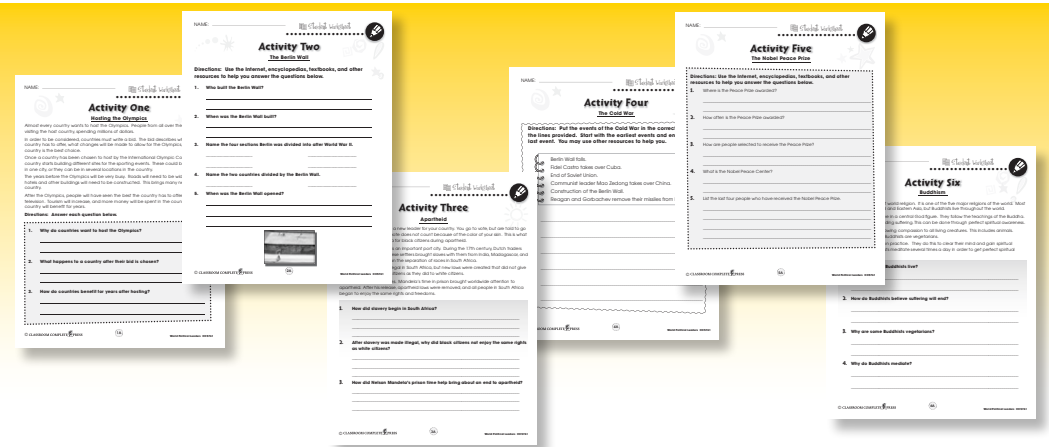

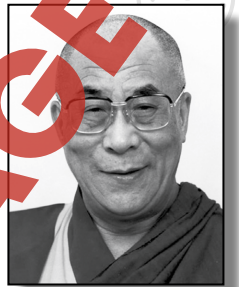

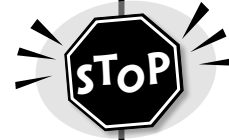
The Dalai Lama

Tenzin Gyatso is the 14th Dalai Lama. He is the head of state and spiritual leader of Tibet. The Dalai Lama is also called His Holiness. He is the main leader of the Buddhist religion.



The Dalai Lama was discovered to be the reincarnated spirit of the last Dalai Lama at the age of two. He was groomed to be the Dalai Lama during his childhood.

How did Tenzin Gyatso become the Dalai Lama?



He took over as the Dalai Lama after Chinese soldiers invaded Tibet. The Dalai Lama tried to work out a peaceful solution with China. He was not successful. His Holiness had to flee to India where he was given political asylum.

The Dalai Lama worked to get his country back from China. He went to the United Nations for help. This was not successful either.

The Five Point Peace Plan was created by the Dalai Lama. He wanted to establish Tibet as a free zone. He wanted to restore personal freedoms taken away by the Chinese invaders. He wanted to stop the building of nuclear weapons in Tibet. China was dumping nuclear waste in Tibet, and the Dalai Lama wanted that to end. He also wanted to open discussions about freeing Tibet.

China did not agree to the plan. However, the Dalai Lama was recognized for his efforts. He was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize for his work to free Tibet and help people around the world.
