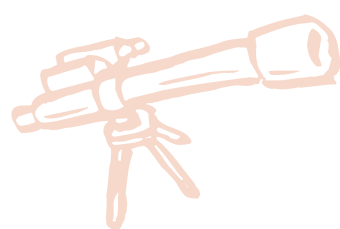
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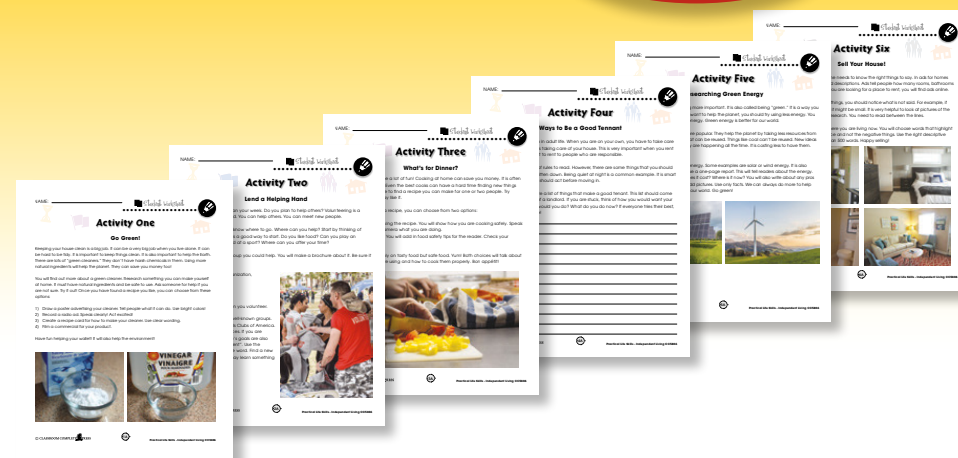

# Tourist in Your Own Town

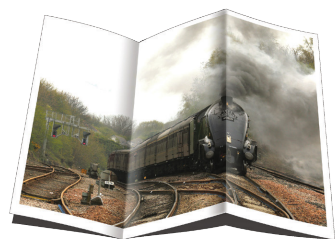

Learn to love your town. When you stay home, you will stay on budget. A local tourist will enjoy their town more. You may be surprised! Bon voyage!

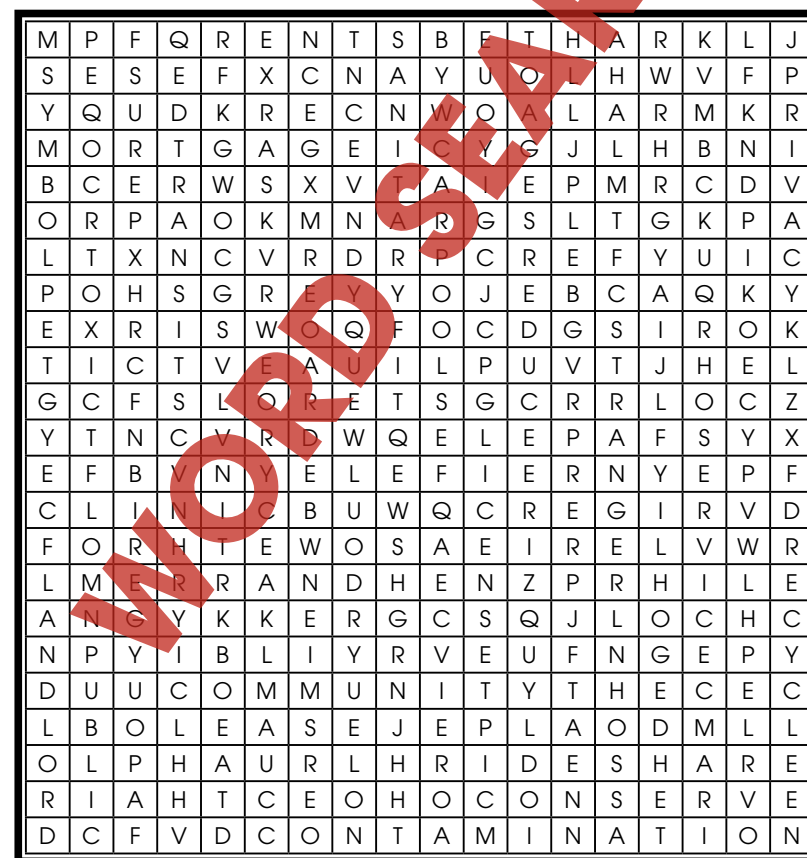

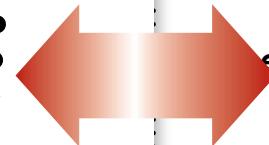
