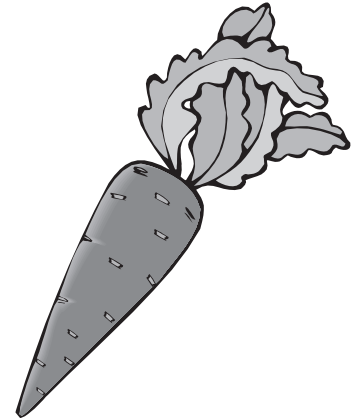

4. Starting with 42 and ending with 49, color in this pattern: Brown, Brown, Black
5. Color 52 through 59 brown.
6. Shade boxes 62-69 brown, except boxes 65 and 66. Shade these pink.
7. Color box 73 brown, and color the next 6 boxes brown.
8. Boxes between 84 and (84+3) should be colored brown.
9. Can you tell what the secret picture is? Draw a mouth to finish it!
