#### Read each of the following direction sets aloud to your students.

- 1. Draw a large circle in the center of the paper.
- 2. Draw a smaller circle in the center of the large circle.
- 3. Shade in two dots inside the small circle. These dots should be placed next to each other; one on the left and one on the right of the small circle.
- 4. Write two capital D<sub>s</sub> above the small circle. Color a small dot in the bottom left corner of each D.
- 5. Write a capital U under the small circle.
- 6. Draw two small triangles on top of the large circle. These triangles should touch the top of the circle.

#### What animal did you draw?

- 1. Draw three small circles in a row in the center of the paper.
- 2. Draw one straight line above all three circles.
- 3. Connect the ends of the line with a very large capital U. This U should go all the way around the three small circles.
- 4. Draw a row of small letter Us from the right end of the line all the way to the right edge of your paper. Make sure all of these Us are connected.
- 5. Draw a row of small letter Us from the left end of the line all the way to the left edge of your paper. Make sure all of these Us are connected.
- 6. Draw a very thin rectangle that starts in the middle of the straight line and goes up and down (not left to right).
- 7. Draw a triangle that connects to your rectangle. One long side of the rectangle should also be one side of your triangle.
