Location

Mexico is located at the southern part of North America. Covering nearly 760,000 square miles, Mexico shares a northern border with the United States and a southeastern border with Guatemala and Belize in South America. To the west of Mexico lies the Pacific Ocean, and the Gulf of Mexico and the Caribbean Sea run along much of the country's eastern coastline.



The People

Throughout history, many groups of Native Americans have lived on the land we now call Mexico. Descendents of many of these groups, including the Aztecs, Mayans, and Toltecs, continue to live in Mexico today. But mestizos, or people of European and Native American ancestry, make up the largest part of the Mexican population. Today, more than 100 million people of all backgrounds live in Mexico.

Spanish is the official language of Mexico, but nearly 100 native languages are also spoken. Mayan and Nahuatl (noo-WAHT-uhl) are both languages commonly heard in different parts of the country.


