Classroom Thief!



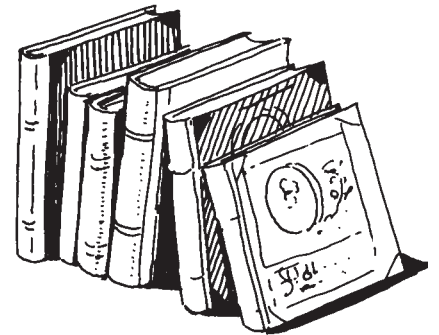
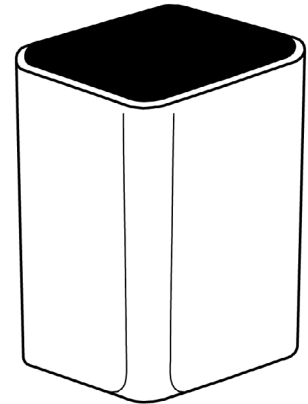
