Ingredients:

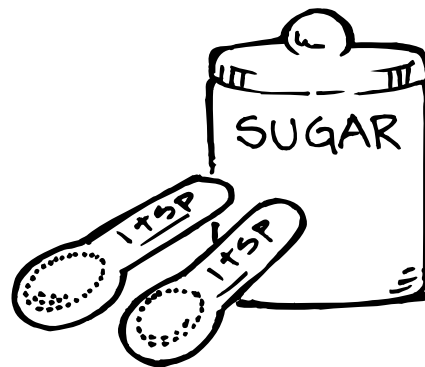
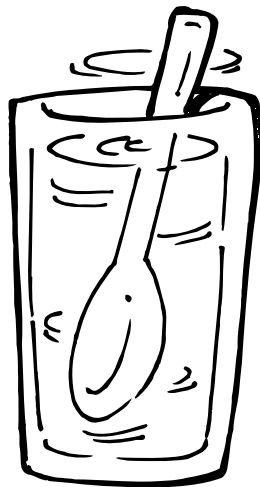
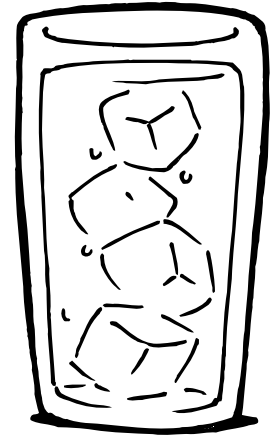
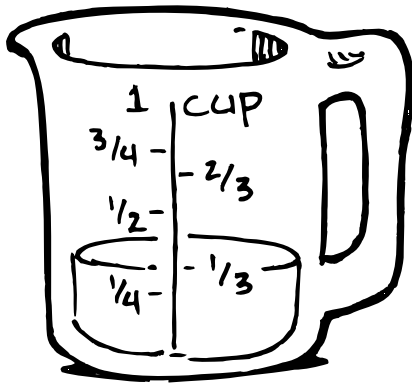
$\frac{1}{2}$ lemon

Squeeze $\frac{1}{2}$ lemon. Pour juice into a glass. Add sugar and water. Stir. Add four ice cubes. Makes 1 serving.

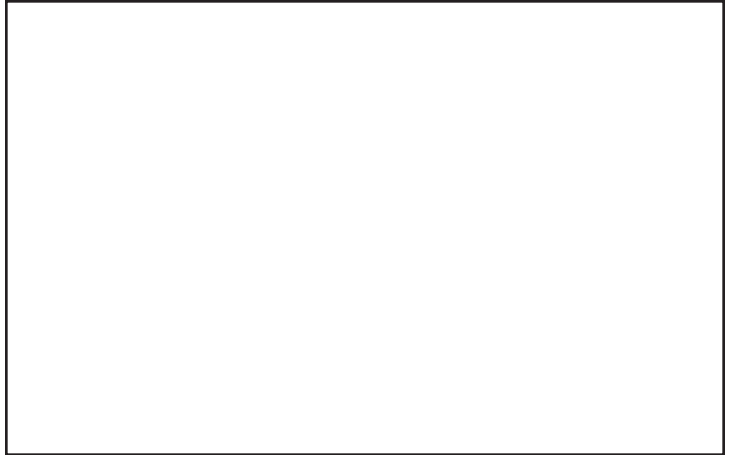
When he grew up, Dr. King spoke to people about changing unfair laws. He said it was his dream that someday skin color would not matter. Everyone would be treated equally.

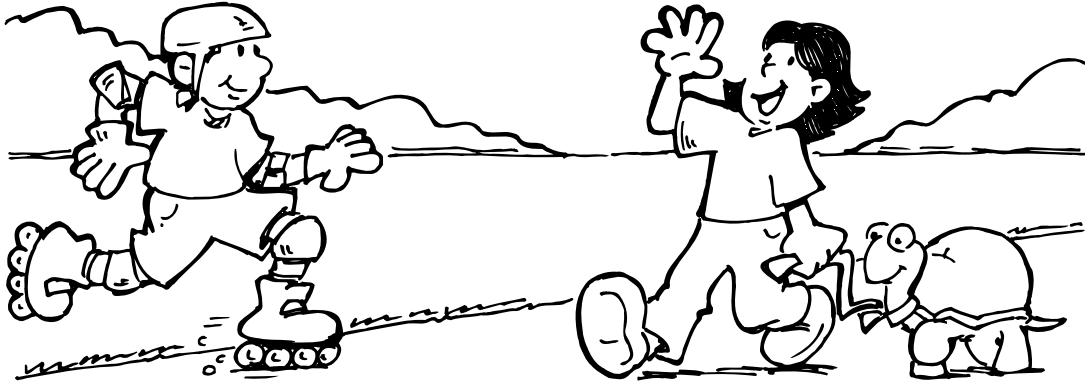
