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
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Bulletin Board Ideas

Children enjoy decorating their classroom during the first few days of school. On a large bulletin board, place representations of a street, a large yellow bus, a sidewalk, and a school.



Have the children draw pictures of themselves on pieces of 9 x 12–in. (23 x 30–cm) construction paper. They should draw themselves as though they were walking or riding to school. You may want them to look at a picture of themselves or at themselves in a mirror as they draw.

When they are finished drawing, have the children cut their pictures out, leaving a margin around their lines. After the children have cut their pictures out, the pictures may be placed on appropriate areas of the bulletin board.

A fitting caption for the bulletin board might be "How We Get To School."

September Calendar

The apple pattern below can be duplicated, and numbers can be put on each apple. Punch a hole in the top of each apple. Then hang the apples on a hook. A child can lift each day's number from its hook and place it over another hook on the corresponding day on the calendar board. A transparency can be made of the picture on the following page. It can be enlarged by using the overhead projector. Trace the picture on a large sheet of poster board and use it at the top of the calendar. Color it with marking pens and laminate it for a long—lasting poster.
