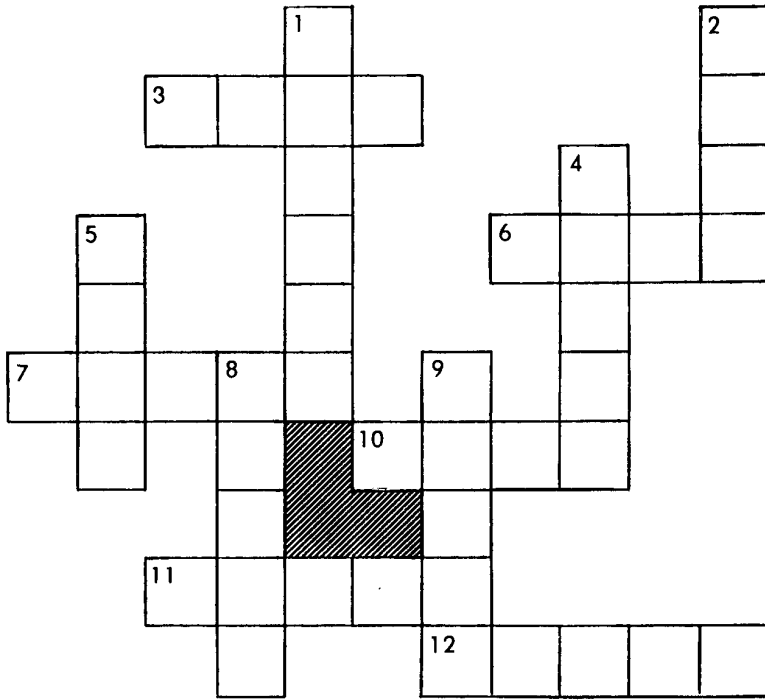


# Following Directions

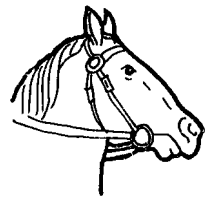
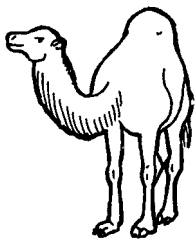
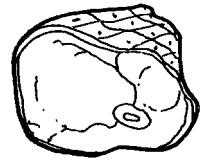
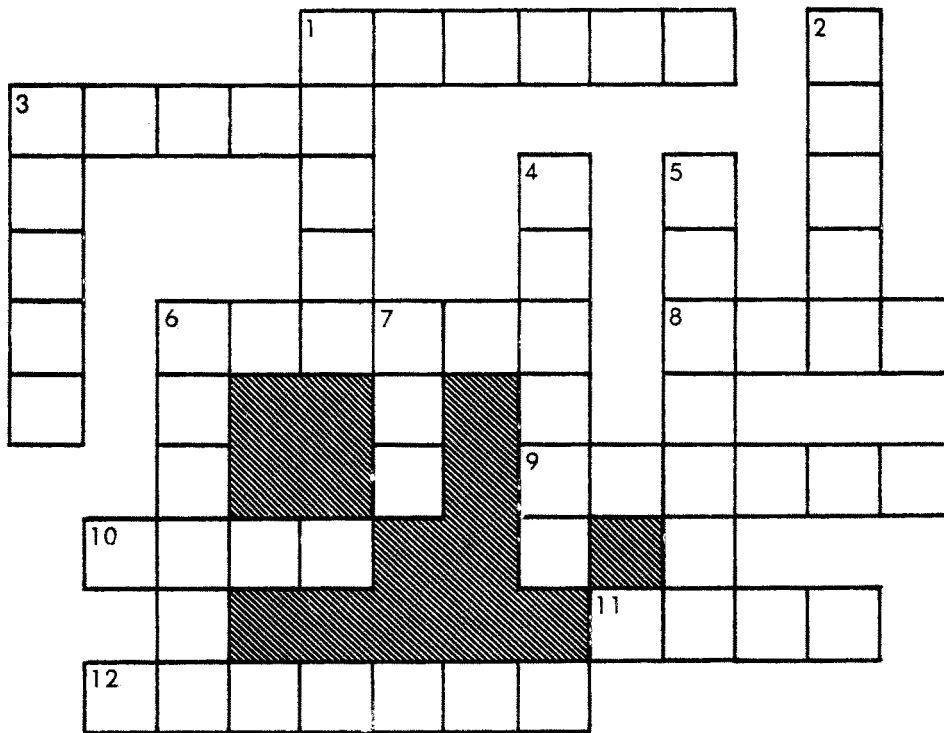
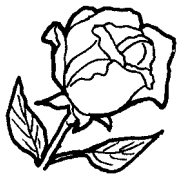
Read the following sentences very carefully and complete the puzzles by following the directions exactly.
