This activity workbook is designed to give students practice in the formation of cursive letters as well as cursive letter connections. Each letter is introduced with numbered, step-by-step instructions for forming the letter or letter connection.

Additionally, there are several lines for practice. If a student is having difficulty with a particular letter formation, try to identify at which stroke he or she is encountering

difficulty. Practice these strokes individually before attempting to draw the actual letter.

Legible handwriting is an asset and more emphasis should be placed on the art of handwriting and its role in communication.

Good cursive writing comes with practice. These pages offer a sequential program of development and practice with examples for guidance.
