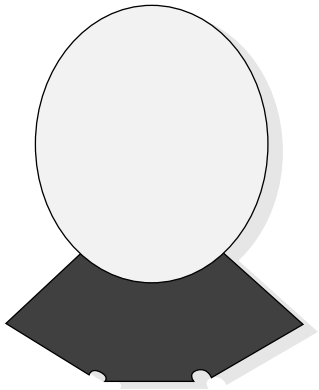


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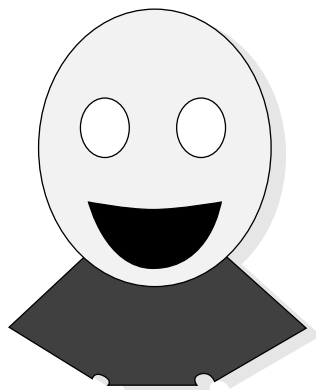
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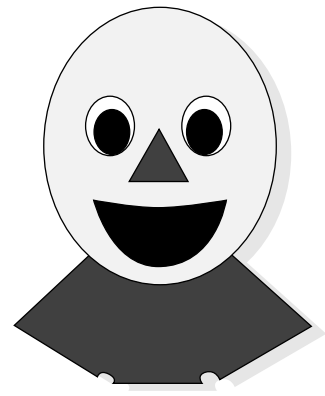
SCARECROW



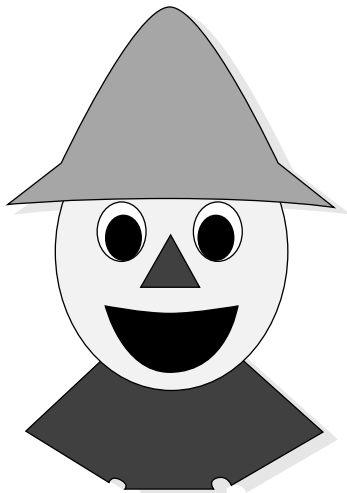
1 Cut one #1 head from yellow paper. Cut one #2 collar from red paper. Glue the head to the collar as shown.



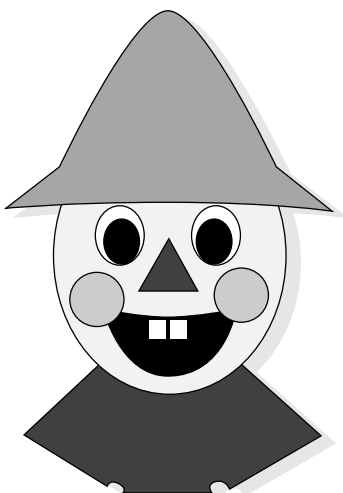
2 Cut one #3 mouth from black paper. Cut two #4 eyes from white paper. Glue them to the head as shown.



3 Cut two #5 eyes from black paper. Cut one #6 nose from red paper. Glue as shown.



4 Cut one #7 hat from blue paper and glue to the top of the head, above the eyes.



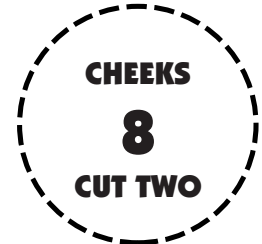
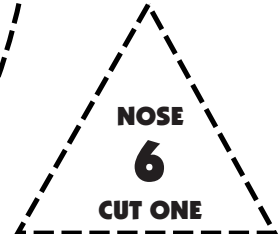
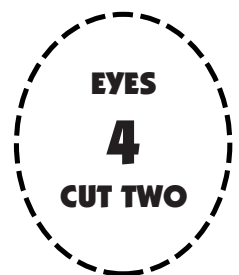
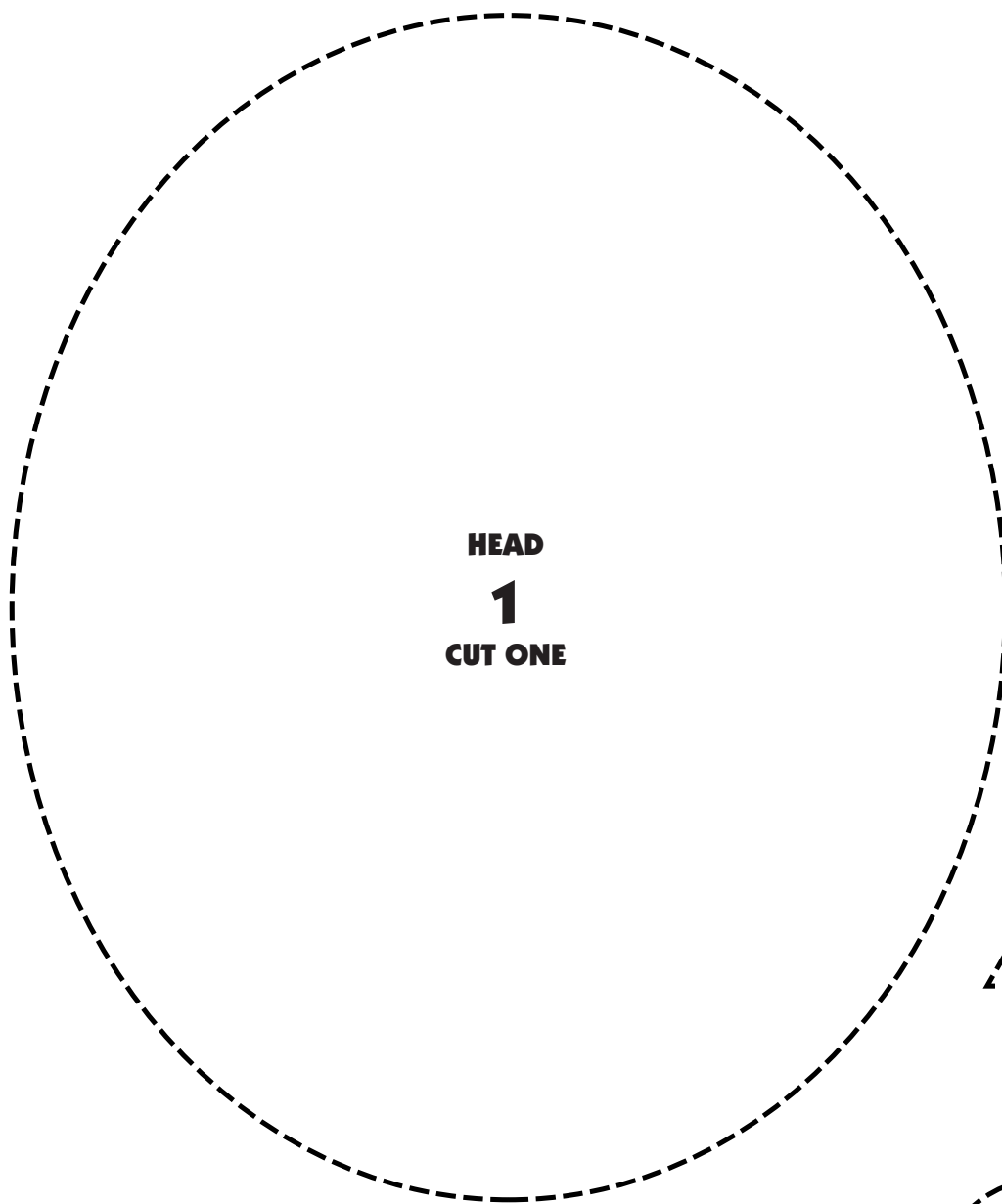
5 Cut two #8 cheeks from pink or orange paper. Cut two #9 teeth from white paper. Glue them as shown.



6 **Optional:** Add patterned patches cut from wallpaper book. Add a bow tied from yarn. Use a drop of glue to attach it to the chin. Glue three or four pieces of broom straw to the underside of the hat.

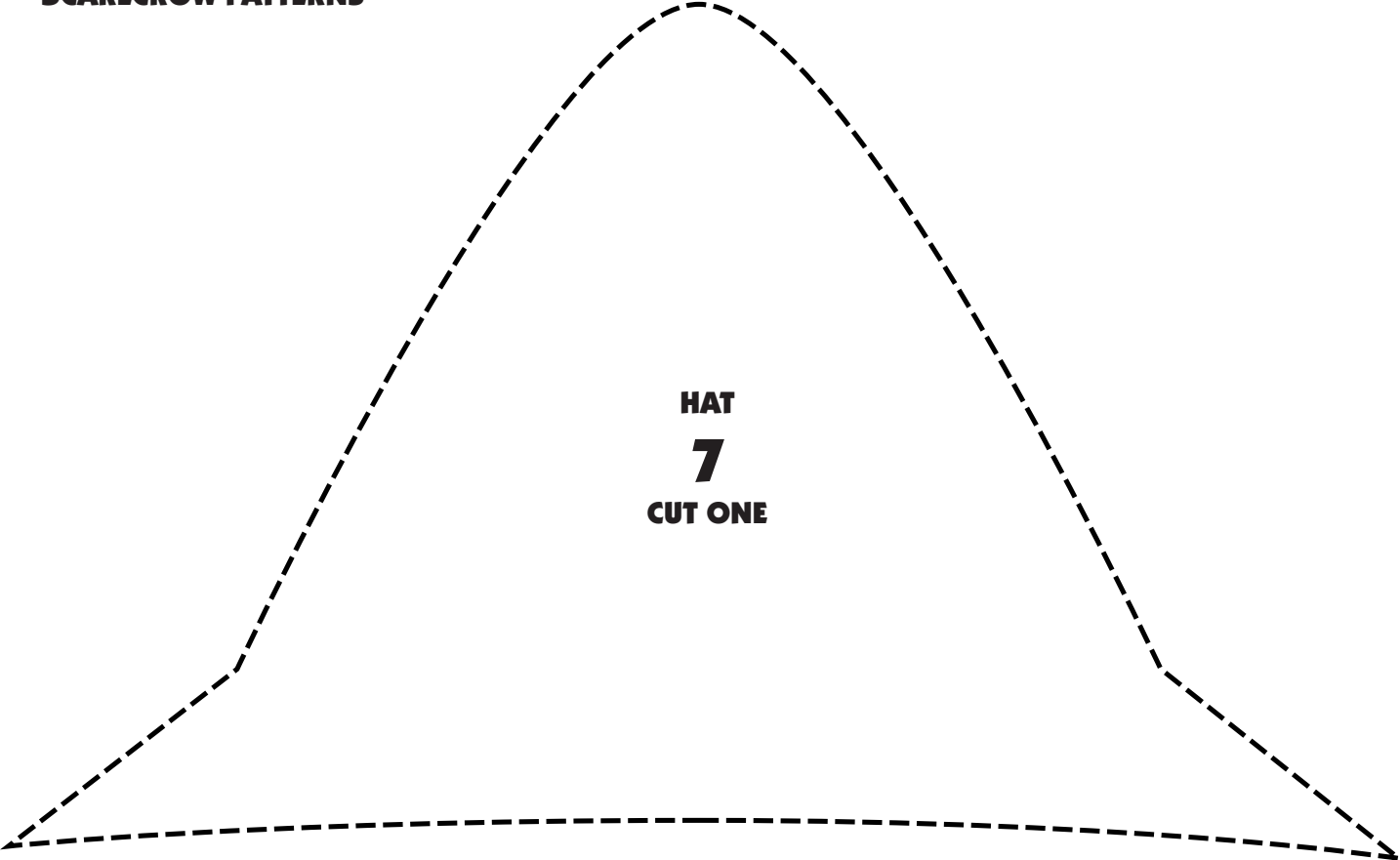

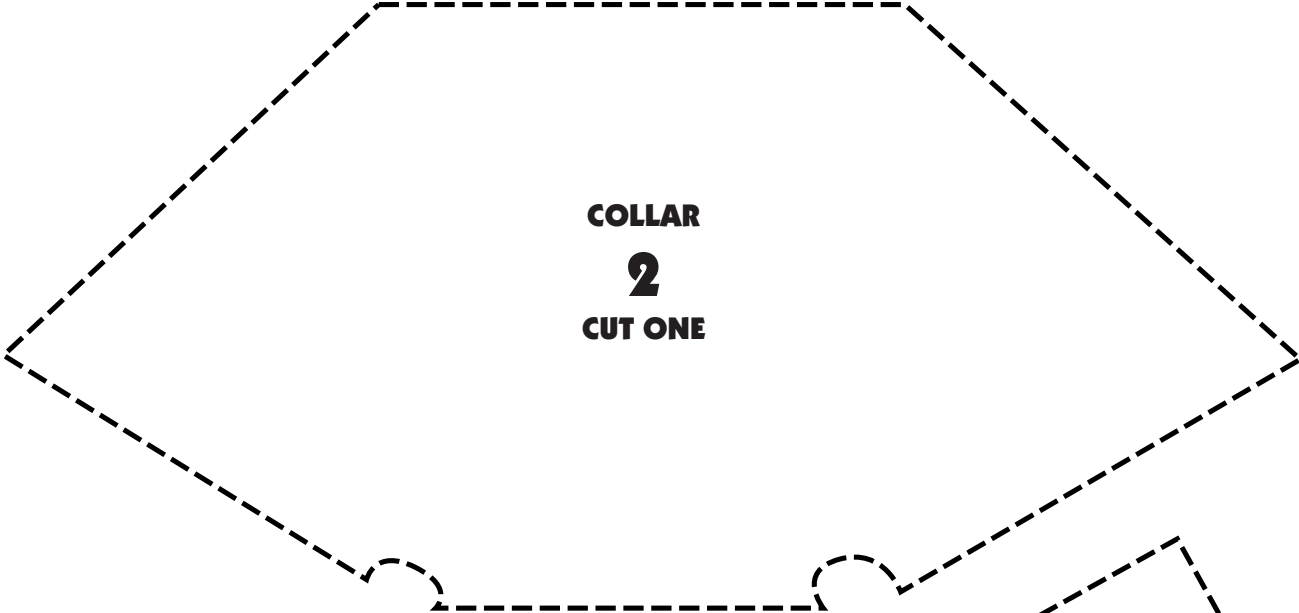
Note:

If it is too small for your students to manipulate without frustration, omit the teeth.



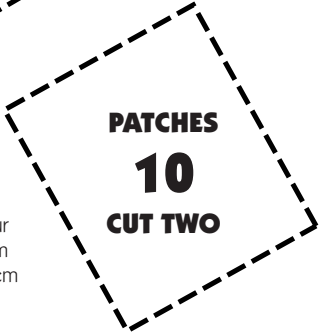
