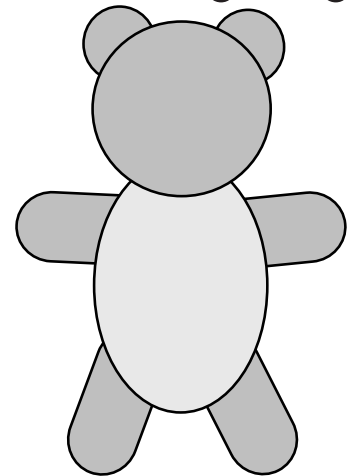
BABY BEAR



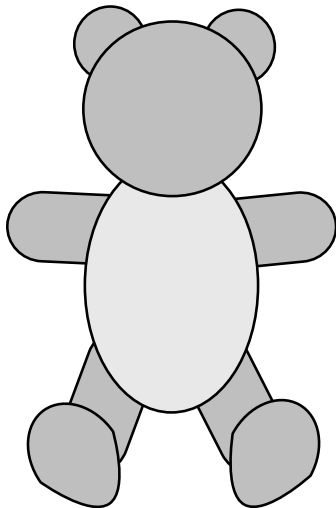
1 Cut one #1 head from brown paper. Cut two #2 ears from brown paper. Glue the ears to the back of the head as shown.



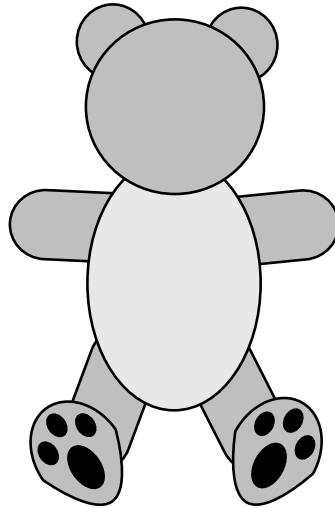
2 Cut one #3 body from tan paper. Glue the body to the back of the head as shown.



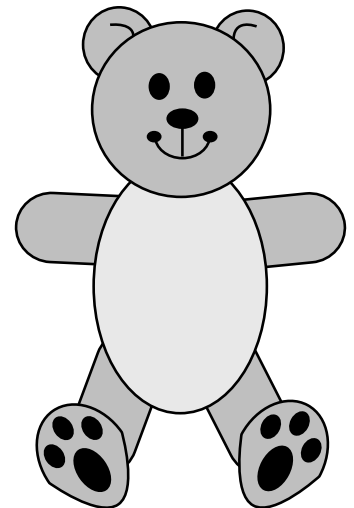
3 Cut four #4 arms/legs from brown paper. Glue them as shown to the back of the body.



4 Cut two #5 feet from brown paper. Glue the feet to the bottoms of the legs as shown.



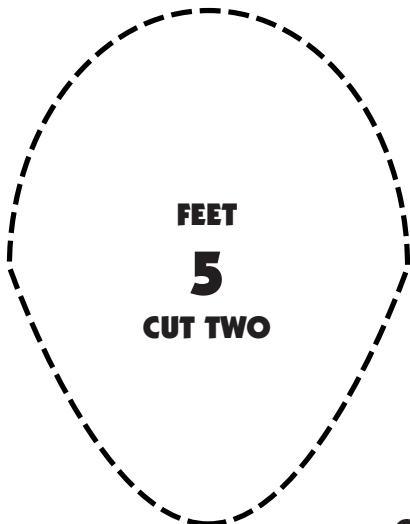
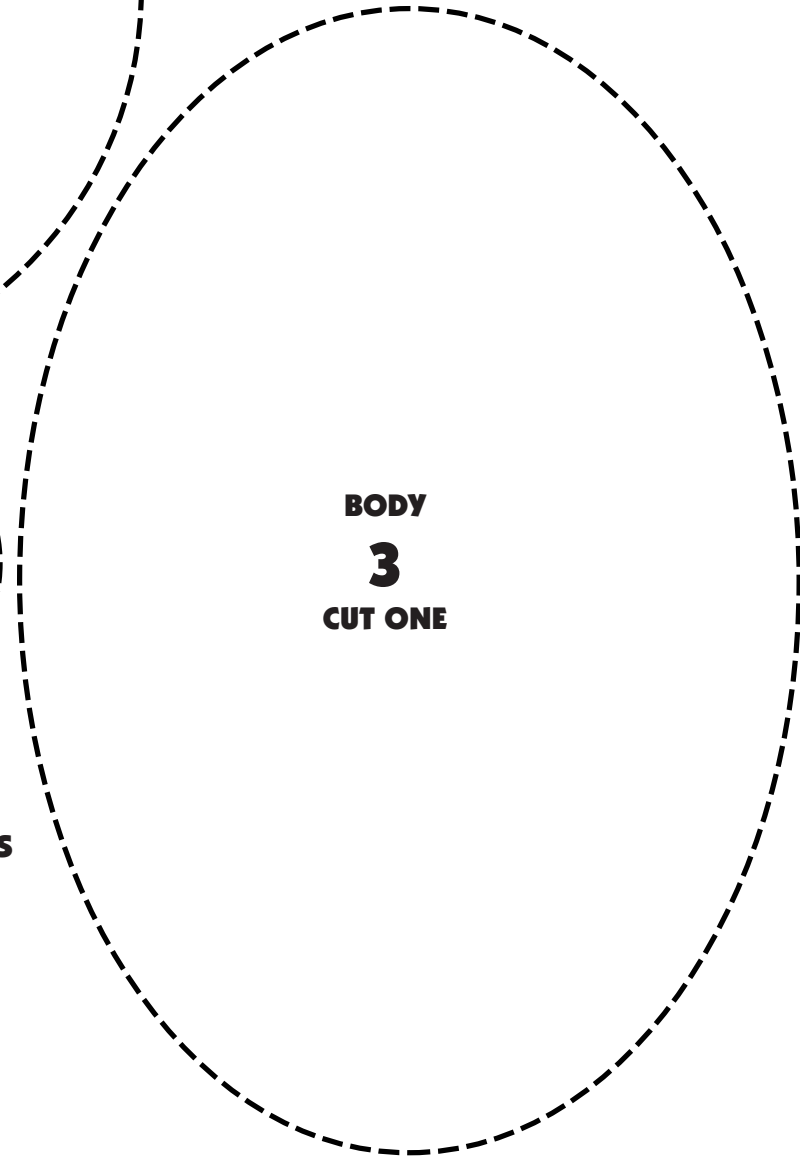
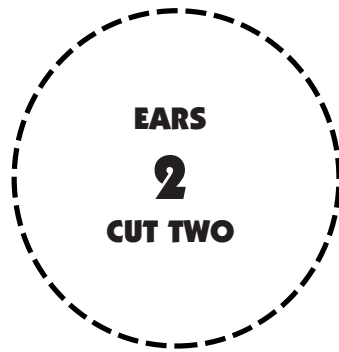
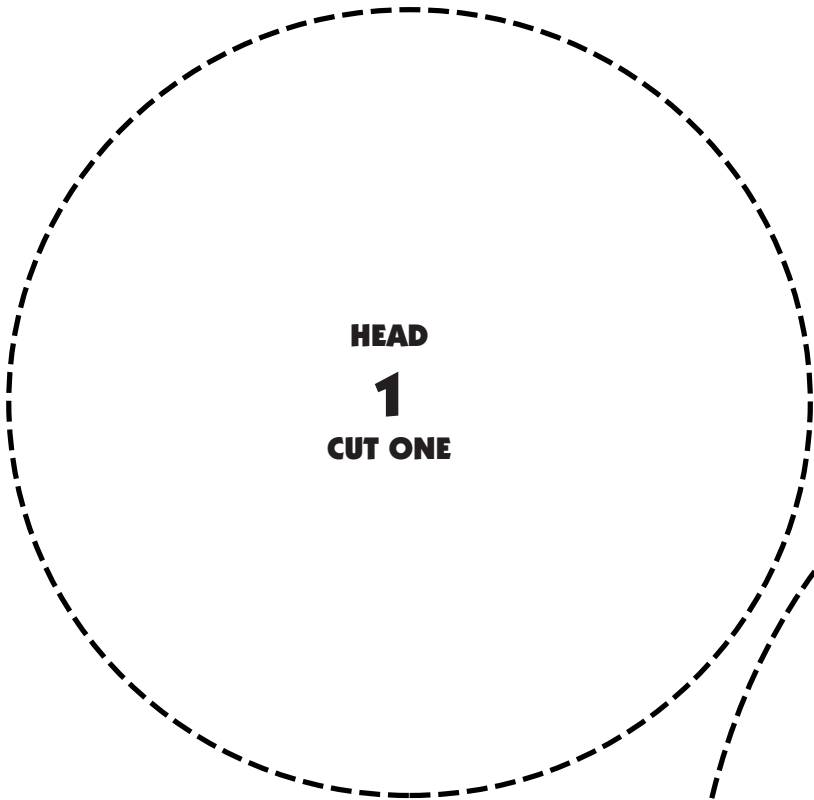
5 Cut two #6 and six #7 paw prints from black paper. Glue on the feet as illustrated.



6 Cut two #8 eyes from black paper and glue on the head. Cut one #9 nose from black paper and glue in place as shown. With a black crayon or marker, draw the mouth and lines on the ears as shown.

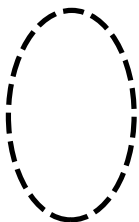


BABY BEAR PATTERNS

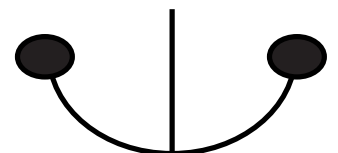


NOSE
