

HOW TO USE THIS BOOK

Each letter has its own art page with an illustration of many items using the featured letter. You may have children:

- circle the items that begin with or include that letter.
- color the items that begin with or include that letter.
- color the entire page.
- work together in large or small groups to call out the items while you write them on the board or chart paper.




At the top of the page, there is a sentence that tells about the picture. The words that start with the featured letter are underlined.

Each letter also has its own spelling page, where children can write and read words that name items from the picture that begin with or use the featured letter.

Sometimes the picture on this page will not look exactly like the picture on the art page, but it will still name the

same thing.




Whenever there is more than one item pictured on this page, children should write the plural for the word.

For more challenging words, some letters will be provided to help children with their spelling. These are Bonus Words, and you may want to make them optional or complete them as a group, depending on the abilities of your class.

At the bottom of the page, there are words for children to read that have the featured letter in them. When they find these items on the art page, they can check off the words.


