

Nutrition

Nutrition is about the foods we eat. Good nutrition keeps our bodies healthy. With good nutrition, we can work, grow, and rest.

We get good nutrition from plants. Trees are one kind of plant. We get fruits like apples and pears from trees. We also get nutrition from small plants like rice and oats. From another small plant, we get wheat for our bread.
