



Apples - Input Suggestions Brainstorm and chart the vocabulary the students will need to use in their activities. Cut out the chart paper in shapes. (an apple, 1/2 apple, bus, bushel) Chart titles: Apples taste... 2. From Seed to Applesauce 3. Apple products 2. Apple Day Everyone brings an apple to observe and eat. Graph the kinds of apples. Count the number of bites it takes to eat the apple. Count the seeds. Compare the sizes by measuring. -Make applesauce. 3. Puzzles Cut out pictures from magazines, colouring books, food calendars, ... Mount and laminate the pictures. Cut them up and use them as puzzles. The puzzles in this unit should be coloured, mounted and laminated. The activities should be put into a small box or envelope with instructions. Put lined or apple shaped paper with the puzzles. Student can print the results after another student or the teacher has checked their work. Put matching activities in an apple shaped folder. Write the Sequence recipe


Milk bags will hold stencils or pieces needed to complete the activities.
