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## The First Easter

Jesus lived in Judea, a land now called Israel. When he was about thirty years old, he began to teach people about God and to help the sick or troubled people. As news spread, Jesus was joined by twelve followers who were known as his Disciples.

Many people grew to love Jesus and some men grew afraid and jealous of all the love people were showing for Jesus. They plotted against Jesus and paid one of his Disciples to betray him. That man's name was Judas.

On Palm Sunday, Jesus rode into Jerusalem to preach in a temple. He rode upon a donkey and people laid palm tree leaves on the roadway before him.

On the Thursday, Jesus had the last supper he was to have with his Disciples, even though God told him that one of his followers would betray him.

Judas came to the supper but left early. He returned with armed men to take Jesus away.

Jesus was found guilty of calling himself the Son of God. Pontius Pilate, the Roman governor who ruled over Judea, gave his permission to kill Jesus.

On Good Friday, Jesus was taken to the Hill of Calvary, where he was crucified upon a cross. Roman soldiers laughed at him and placed a crown of thorns upon his head because people said he was a King of Israel.

## The Story of Chocolate

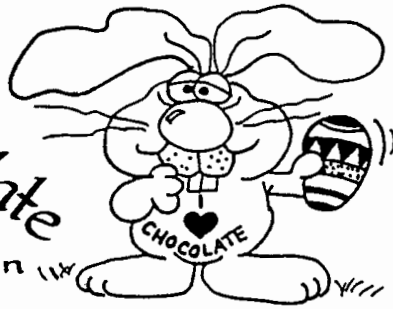
### Making Chocolate

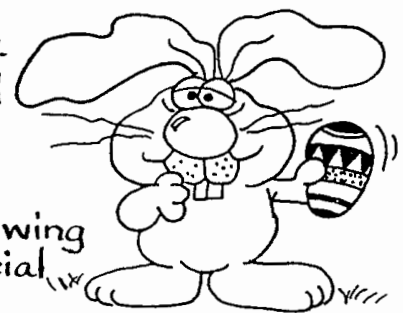

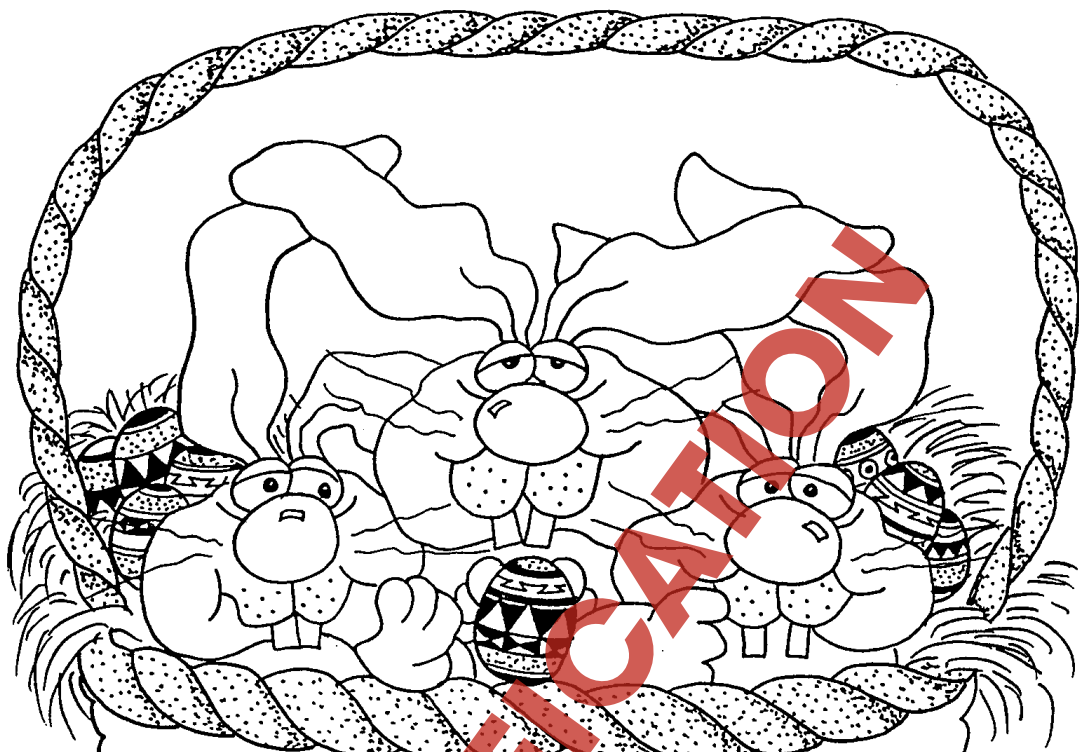
## 'Home Sweet Home'

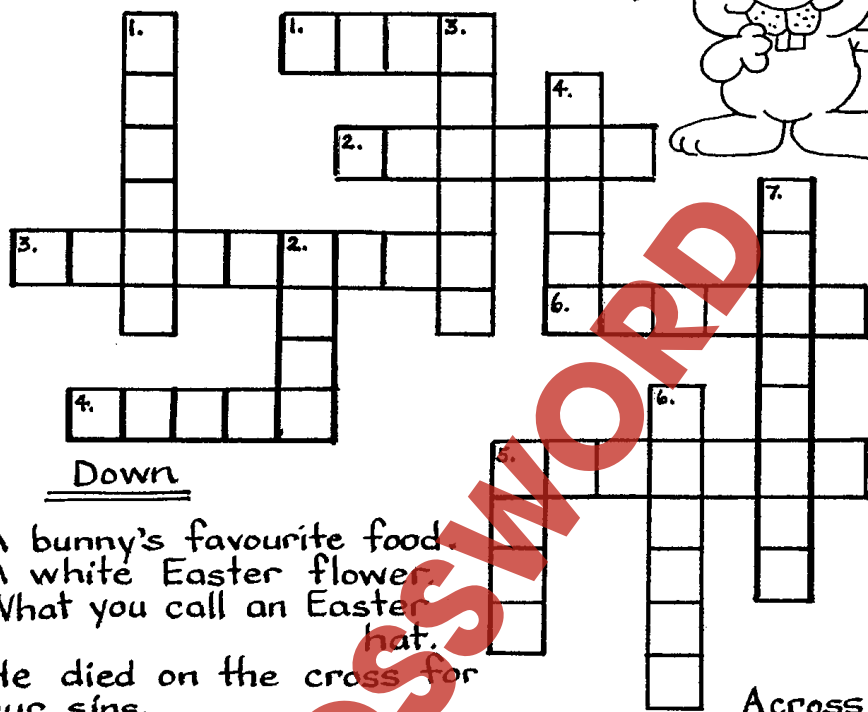
