



ACTIVITIES IN THIS PACKAGE

Do only the activities that meet the needs of your students.

1. Reading

The reading cards can be used as individualized activities or for class discussions and seatwork.

Sequence Activities

Cut out, mount and laminate the sequence pictures.

- 1) Students arrange the pictures in order and say the nursery rhyme.
- 2) Students paste the pictures in order, then print the rhyme to match the pictures.
- 3) Sequence the sentences, then draw the pictures.
- 4) Show the rhymes in a cartoon strip.

2. Mathematics:

Add the number facts you are working on to the gameboard included. Use a table top gameboard or make a gameboard on bristol board.

3. Phonics:

Incorporate the phonics concepts you are working on.

Reinforce the phonics through games.

(Bingo, Riddles, Listening Games)

4. Word Study:

Students can make up individual word booklets for: Opposites, Compound Words, Things That Go Together, Rhyming Words, Number Booklets, Dictionaries.

5. Brainstorming:

Let the students add pictures and words to charts each day.

Oral discussion will promote language development and creative thinking.
