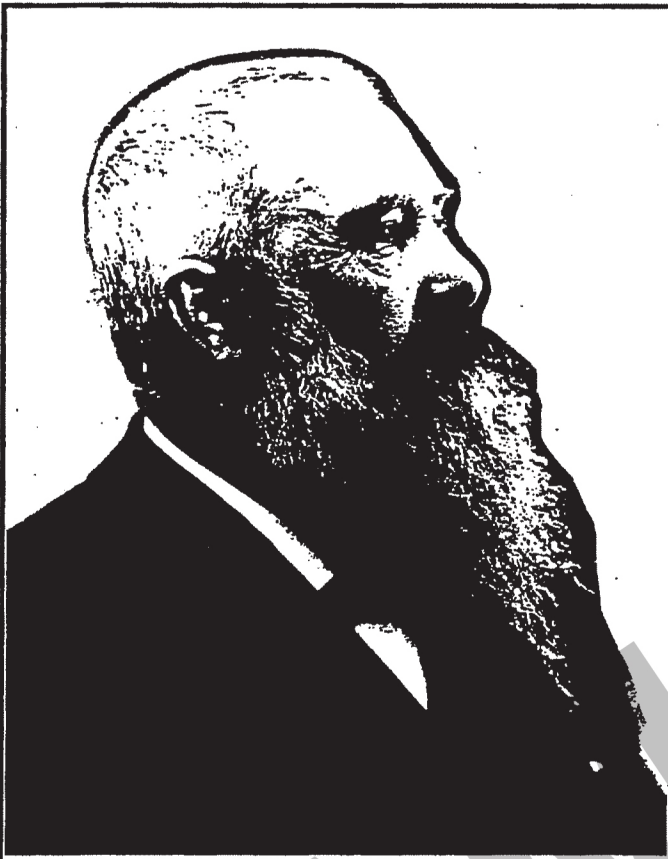

Portrait of Monet




