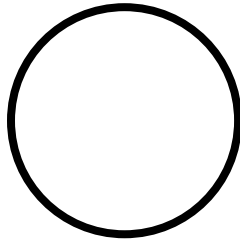

A. Read this story.

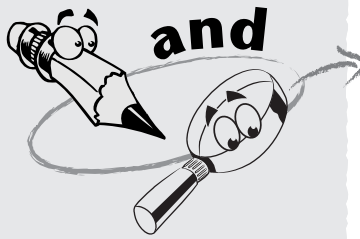
On the way home from  school,

 Will said.

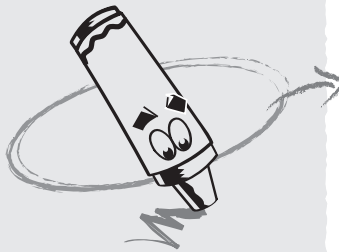

 circles.”

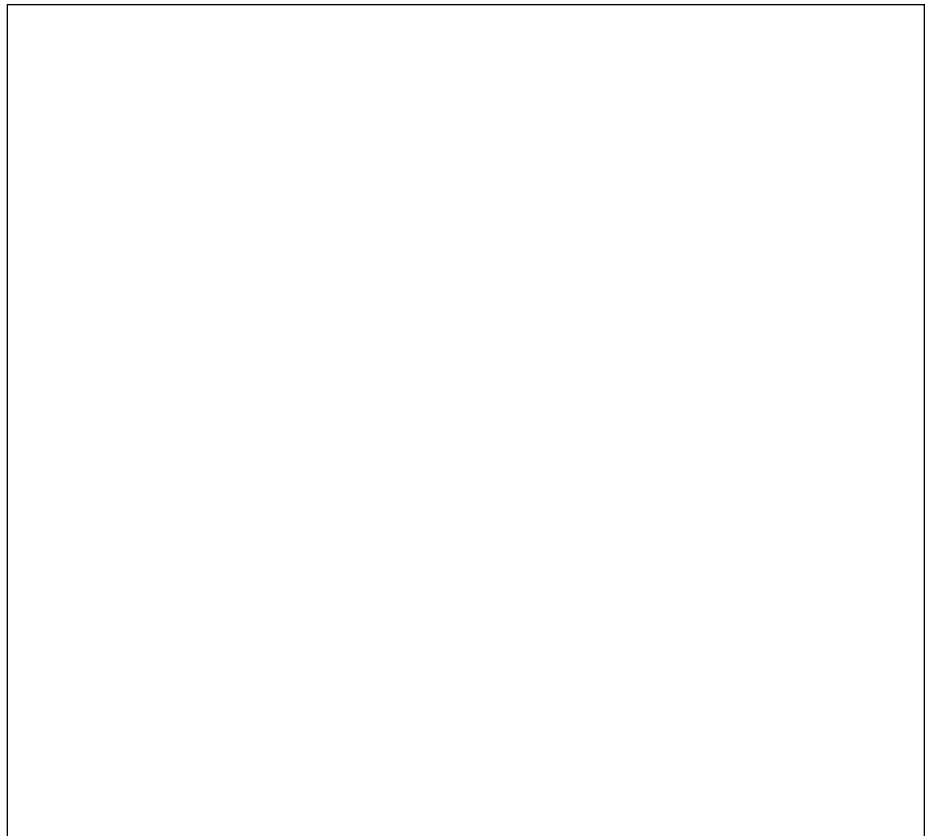
