

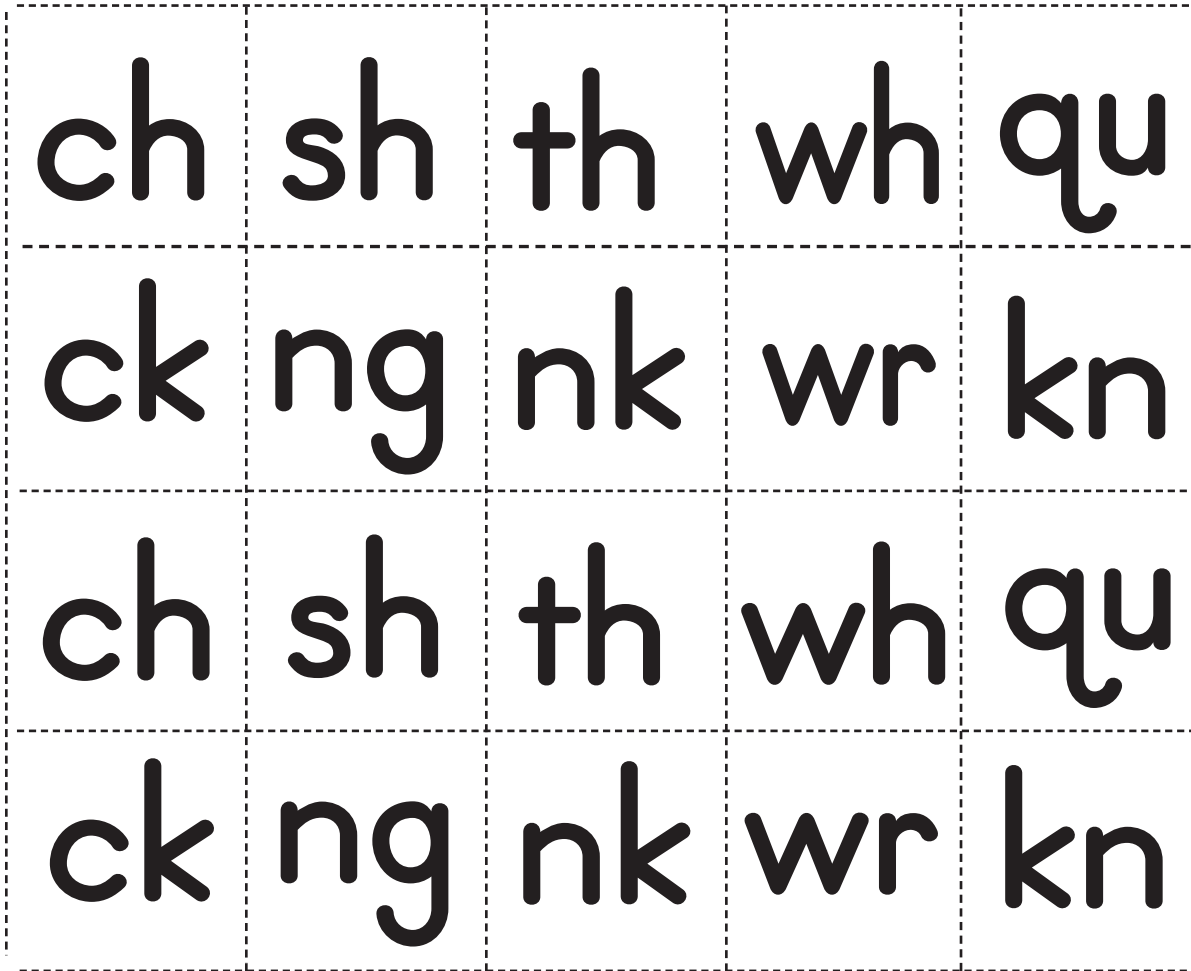

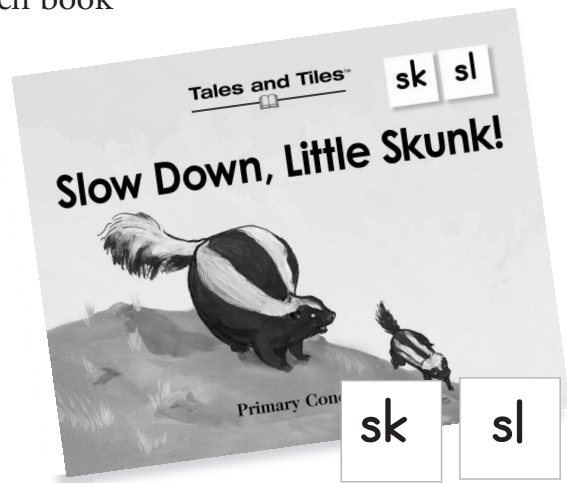

Overview

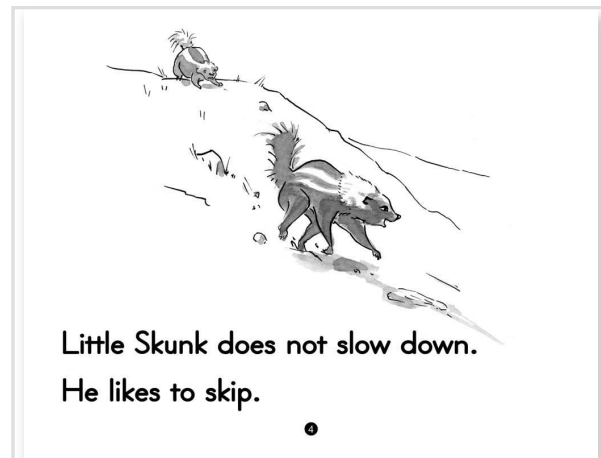
There are four sets of *Tales and Tiles Phonics Readers*. The *Short and Long Vowels* set focuses on short vowels and the final silent *e* pattern. The *Vowel Pairs* set focuses on medial vowel pairs, such as *ai* or *ea*. The *Consonant Pairs* set focuses on digraphs and blends, such as *ch* or *ng*. Each book in the *Beginning Blends* set focuses on two beginning blends, such as *cl* and *cr*. Each captivating tale highlights a different phonics pattern.

Tiles, included with each set, help young children identify the phonics pattern in connected text. Designed to complement and support any phonics or reading program, the interactive stories make frequent use of the target phonics pattern and high frequency sight words.



After you have introduced a book, children can search for words in the story that contain the focus phonogram, build the words with tiles, and record the words in a *Word Study Notebook*.

Tales and Tiles Phonics Readers enables you to supplement your *Tales and Tiles* library by printing black and white copies of the books. The printed copies make it possible for children to circle the focus words directly in their books, color the pictures, and write their names on their own copies. Children can take the books home and practice reading them again and again.



Summary Charts list the titles in the *Phonics Readers* series, their focus phonics pattern, and the words you will find in the books.

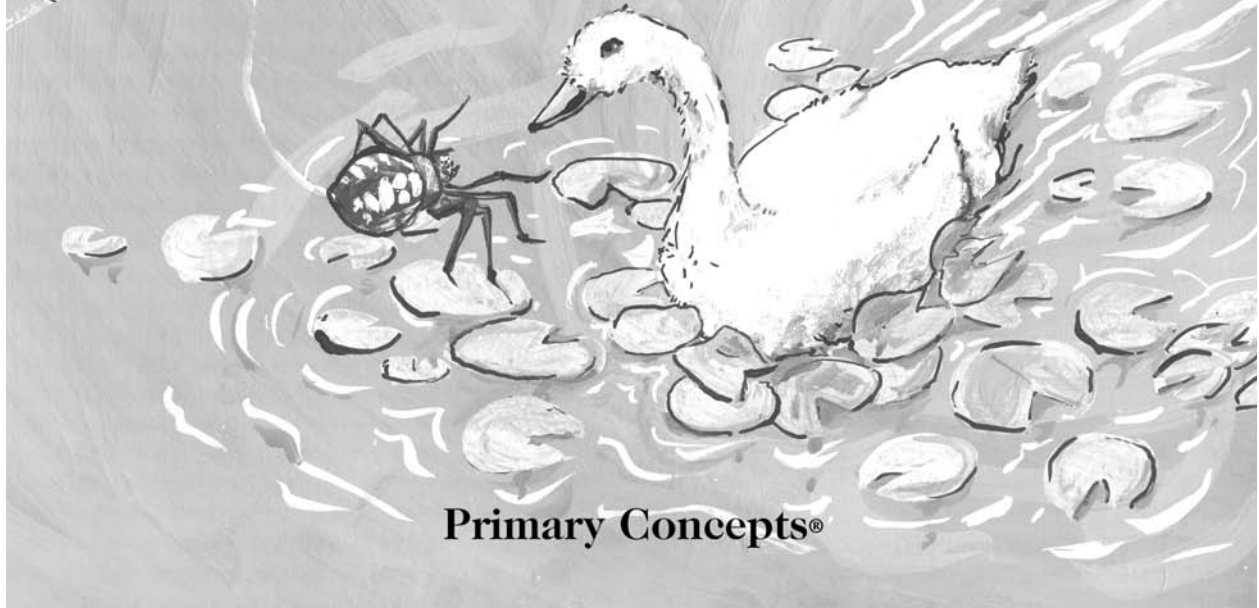

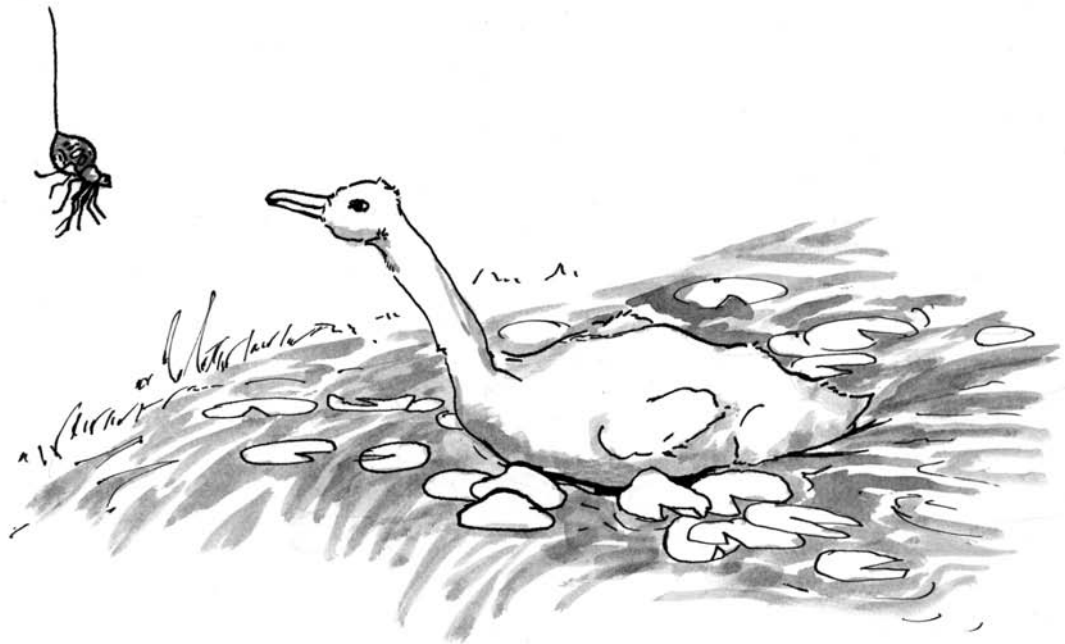
