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Overview


in the *Beginning Blends* set focuses on two beginning blends, such as *cl* and *cr*. Each captivating tale highlights a different phonics pattern.


After you have introduced a book, children can search for words in the story that contain the focus phonogram, build the words with tiles, and record the words in a *Word Study Notebook*.
