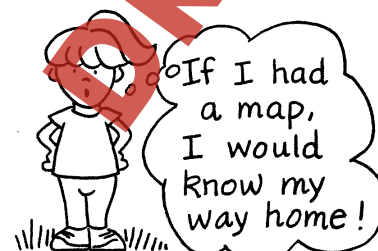

☆ FAIRY TALES ☆

This workfile is based on traditional FAIRY TALES. The activities inside, however, are new and exciting. You will find:

1. 20 Task Cards, most being open-ended. Each has a delightful illustration that lends to the activity.
2. A student record sheet for his/her Learning Center Workbook.
3. 4 fully illustrated stories; The Frog Prince, The Little Red Hen, Goldilocks and The Ugly Duckling.
4. A FAIRY TALE TRIVIA GAME, just for fun! The students can test their trivia skills by answering the question cards.
5. Reinforcement activities for Ordinals, Alphabetical Sequence, Classification, Dialogue, Math, Visual Discrimination
6. Blank Activity Cards and Task Cards for more ideas.

☆ FAIRY TALE TRIVIA GAME ☆

Student Objective: to have fun answering the trivia questions.

You'll need: 1 colored letter size file folder or a sheet of bristol of comparable size, crayons for coloring, bristol backing for cards, scissors, glue.

1. Color the board game. Color all the squares or just color the figures and the magic wands.
2. Glue the board game to the inside of a lettersize file or bristol. If using the file, the second sheet of the game will have to be trimmed to fit.
3. Cut out the cards and mount on bristol. Cut out again leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " bristol border.*
4. Laminate all the pieces.
5. Store in a large zip close bag at your GAMES LEARNING CENTRE.

* You may also photocopy cards onto construction paper.

☆ FAIRY TALE /SPACE ☆

Student Objective: to classify the fairy tale words and the space words.

You'll need: 1 letter size file, crayons, glue, scissors, construction paper.

1. Photocopy the word page onto a sheet of light colored construction paper, or use as is. Cut out words.
2. Color the illustrative pictures and mount on the inside of the file, one on each side.
3. Laminate all the pieces.
4. Store the words in a small zip close bag. Attach the bag with a paper clip onto the file.
5. Store at your GAMES LEARNING CENTRE.

☆ FAMOUS FAIRY TALE LINES ☆

Student Objective: to match the quotes with the speakers.

You'll need: 1 letter size file, crayons, glue, scissors, construction paper.

Set up the same as FAIRY TALE/SPACE.

☆ RAPUNZEL MATH ACTIVITY ☆

Student Objective: to display the given equation in sets.

You'll need: bristol backing for cards, elastics or hair pins, glue, scissors, crayons

1. Photocopy 5 copies of the RAPUNZEL cards. Color and mount on bristol. Cut out cards leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " bristol border. Or photocopy cards onto construction paper and highlight with color.
2. Fill the blank card sheet with equations $7+2=$ $8+3=$ etc. Alternate equations each week.
