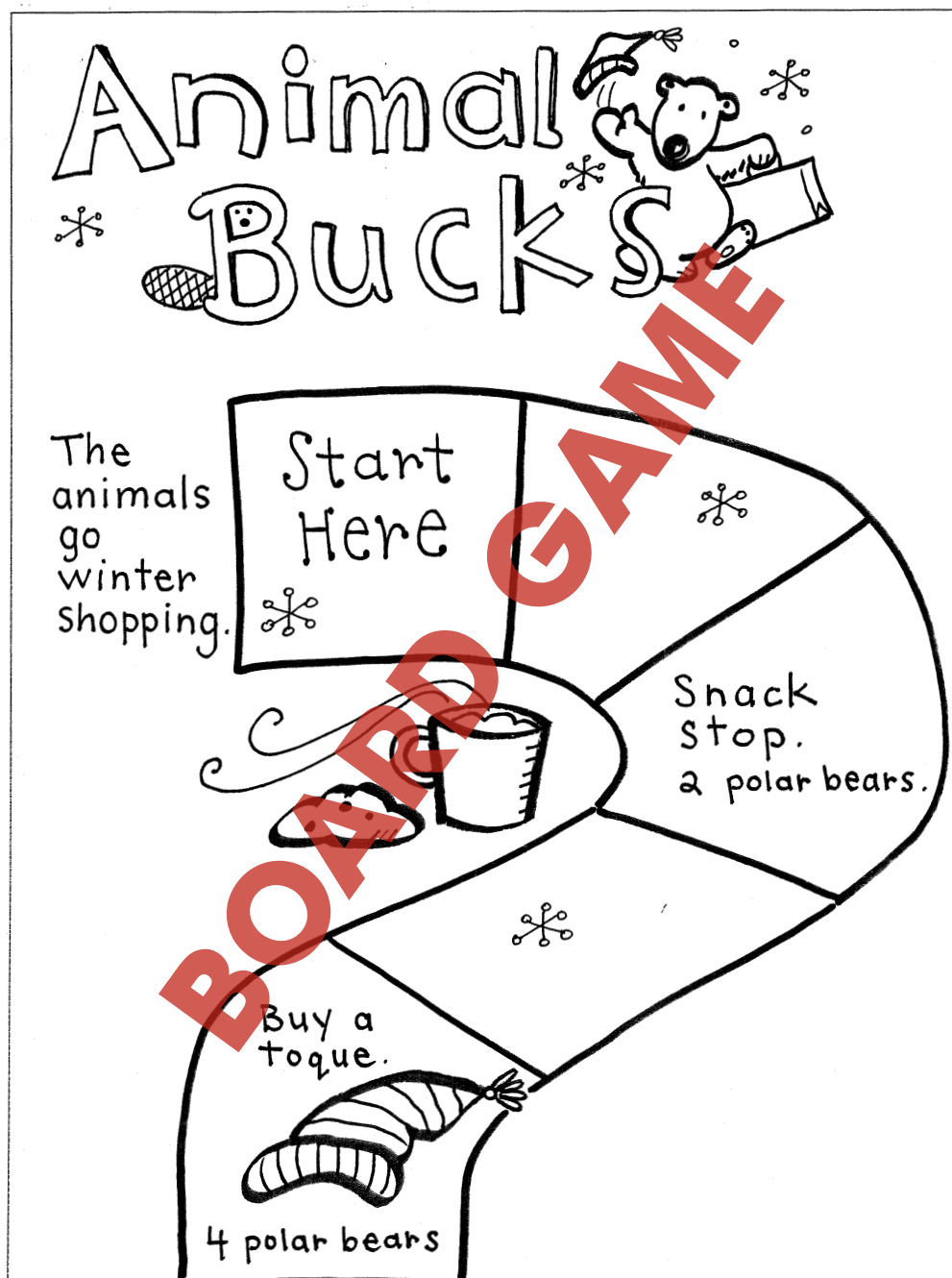

"Do you know where I live?" asked Martha.

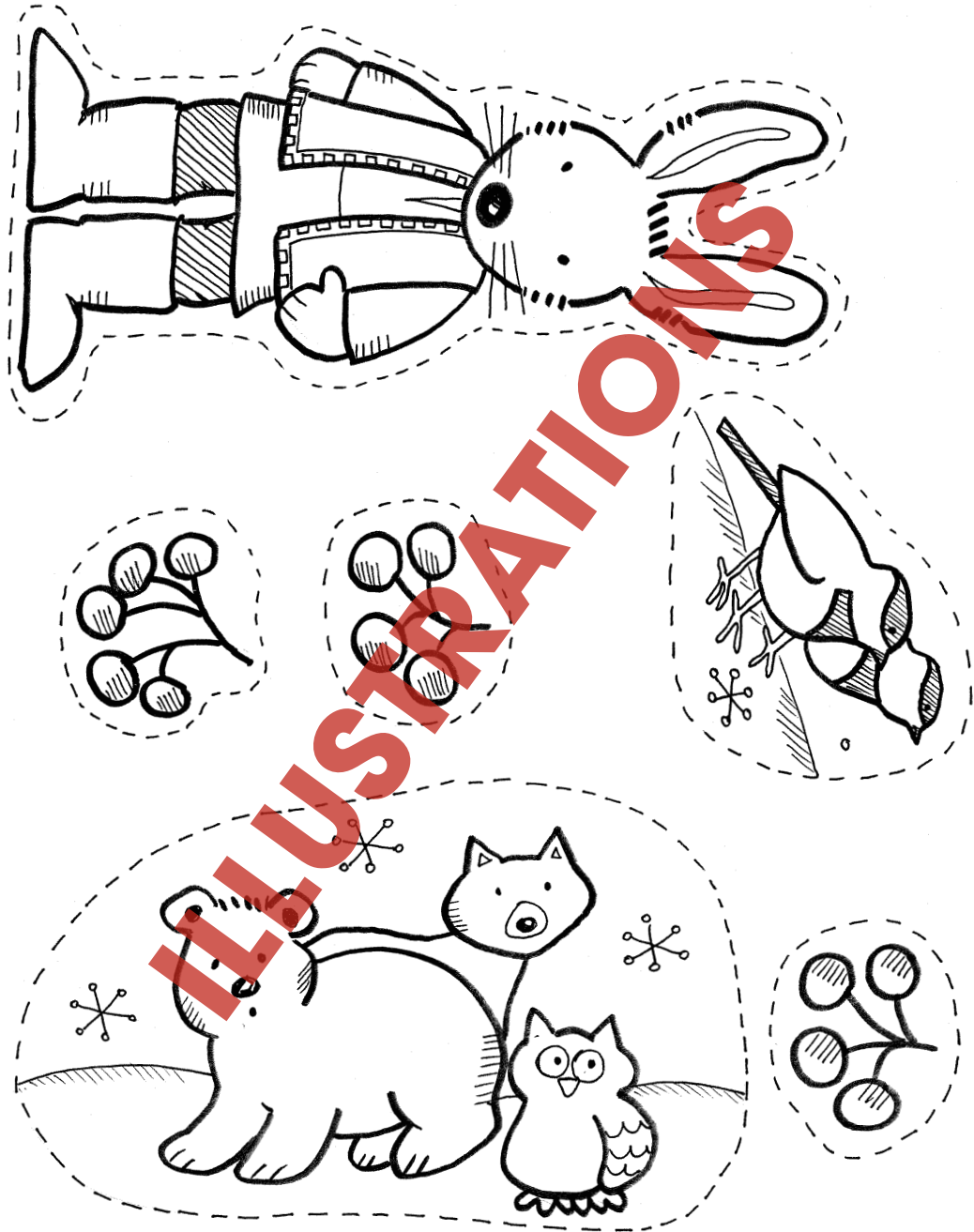
"Sorry, we do not," replied the hares and they kept on dancing.
