
ROCK BAND SIMULATION

UNIT OVERVIEW

In this unit, students will simulate the creation of their own rock band. As well as creating the individual members of the band students will assume the roles of:

- 1) Marketing Director responsible for advertising and promotions
- 2) Newspaper Reporter writes a review of a rock concert
- 3) Accountant in charge of monetary affairs of band

This unit places an emphasis on communication skills (group work) and creative and critical thinking. Specifically this unit is intended to promote both intuitive and imaginative thought.



- 1. <u>Logo</u> Choose bank and design band logo.
- 2. <u>Biographies</u> Draw a 5 cm x 5 cm picture and write a description of each band member.
- 3. <u>Tour Poster or Tape Case Design</u> Design a full colour poster advertising the latest tour or create a tape case design.
- 4. Newspaper Review Write a review of a recent rock concert for a local newspaper.
- 5. Accountant Estimate and calculate expenses of holding a rock concert.

ASSIGNMENT #1 - BAND LOGO

Student Objectives


- students will brainstorm to generate ideas for creating a band name and logo.

Student Activities

- students brainstorm to develop a concept map (web) on "Rock Bands"
- students choose a name for their band
- students design and colour logo for their band

Suggested Teaching Strategies

- Since this is the introductory lesson, the brainstorming a roach joused to spark student interest
- teacher places topic "Rock Band" on board and hallenges students to brainstorm any words related to rock bands
- with student direction, teacher puts word into once, map (ideas here may be rearranged into concept map form)
- after the brainstorming activity is classified, students should choose a name for their band and start designing a logo (insist not students choose a name quickly)
- 9 x 12" manilla tag (stiff yell wish stuff) wrks well for the logo designs

ASSIGNMENTS

1. Logo

Choose a name for your band and design your own logo based on the music your band will play. Make the logo simple and eye catching. BE CREATIVE!

2. <u>Biographies</u>

Your band can include anywhere from four to six members. Draw and autograph a picture of each band member and write a description (100 word minimum) of each band member. Things that you may wish to include are:

- Age, Date of Birth

- Childhood Descriptions

- Physical Description

- Major Accomplishments

- Instruments Played/Style of Play

- Musical Influences

- Hobbies, Likes, Dislikes

3. Full Colour Tour Poster or Tape Case Design

This tour poster or tape case is designed by you, the pusor in charge of advertising and promotions. Its purpose is to advertise your band's hiest tour. Things you may wish to include are:

- Name of Tour, (i.e. Steel Wheels Tour)

Other Cities on Tour

- Place, Date, Ticket Prices

- Promotional Gimmicks

The tape case design should be simple at attractive and must be submitted in an actual plastic cassette case.

4. Review of Concert

Your job will be to write a review of a secent concert. You are a reporter for a major newspaper and have solumn to fill consisting of 250 words. Information you might include:

- Where and with the concert took place
- Number of eople son ert
- Description Lage slow and music
- Description of opening ac
- Audience reaction
- Interviews or quotations of band members
- Interviews or quotations of audience members
- Personal comments and rating of the concert (i.e. Tin, Silver, Gold, Platinum)

5. Accountant

Your job is to calculate the revenue and expenses of the concert tour.

- Ticket and T-Shirt Revenue
- Cost of Stage and Band Equipment
- Security Expenses
- Building Rental
- Travel & Accommodation Expenses
- Equipment Workers (Roadies)
- Miscellaneous Expenses

Estimate total expenses and total revenue for each item and calculate the net profit.

Be ready to justify your estimates as marks will be given for accuracy of estimates.
