UNIT OVERVIEW

This theme, developed for grades 1-3, is designed to explore the books and artwork of Jan Brett. The time frame for this unit is three to four weeks. This can be easily adjusted depending on the goals, needs, and more importantly on the interest of each individual class. Since many of her books have Christmas themes, one suggestion might be to begin the unit shortly before Christmas and then complete it following the Christmas break.

All areas of the curriculum are integrated into this unit, including activities related to: literature, poetry, vocabulary development, math, art, music, social studies, science, life skills, physical education, and parent involvement (extending the unit to the child's home). Many of these activities encourage co-operative learning as students develop an understanding of good literature and an appreciation of fine art.



WHO IS JAN BRETT?

Jan Brett lives in a seacoast town in Massachusetts, close to where she grew up. She lives with her husband, Joe, their daughter and their many pets. All actively take part in her books.

When she was a little girl, Jan Brett loved to read and be read to. She spent many hours looking at picture books and, at an early age, she decided that she would be an author and illustrator of books. She spent many hours as a child with her crayons, paints and paper, drawing pictures just for enjoyment. Later, as a young adult, she became a student at the Boston Museum School. While there, she spent a lot of time in the Museum of Fine Arts where she studied all forms of art: pictures, sculptures, porcelain, and handicrafts.

Today, much of the inspiration for the stories she writes and illustrates come from the stories she heard as a child, as well as the adventures she had as a child. She spends a lot of time travelling to many different countries where she studies the architecture, costumes, customs, and traditions of the country. She makes use of this knowledge in creating the illustrations for her books.

The people in her family, the people she encounters on her travels, and her pets are often the inspiration when creating the personalities and expressions of the characters in her stories.

The First Dog came about because she studied her own Husky, named Perky. She studied the dog's expressions and attempted to guess what the dog was thinking.

The Wild Christmas Reindeer was inspired by her horse, Westy. When she was demanding with the horse, the horse would not co-operate. When she spoke calmly to the horse, the horse would be co-operative. She took this experience, changed the animals and the setting, and a new book was created.
