
Did You Say Dinosaurs?


Welcome to the world of dinosaurs! Here you'll find workjobs and activities to make your Dinosaur Learning Center more complete.

Dinosaurs are a facinating topic for children of all ages. Have fun exploring, discovering and creating!






CLASSIFICATION

Meat Eaters, Plant Eaters

Student Objective: to classify plant eaters and meat eaters.

You'll need I legal size file folder (yellow). crayons, glue, scissors, a zipclose bag

- 1. Duplicate the dinosaurs onto light green construction paper. Cut out and laminate. Or ... color the dinosaurs and mount on 2 ply bristal cut out again leaving a 14" bristal border.
- 2. Color and cutout title picture. 6 lue on the outside of the file.
- 3. Color and cut out the classification illustrations. Glue one on each side of the file. Laminate the file folder.
- 4. Store the dinosaurs in a zipclose bag. Attach to the file.



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


Mega Puzzles
