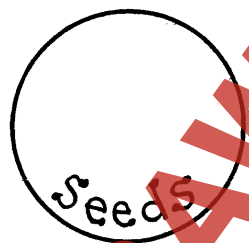

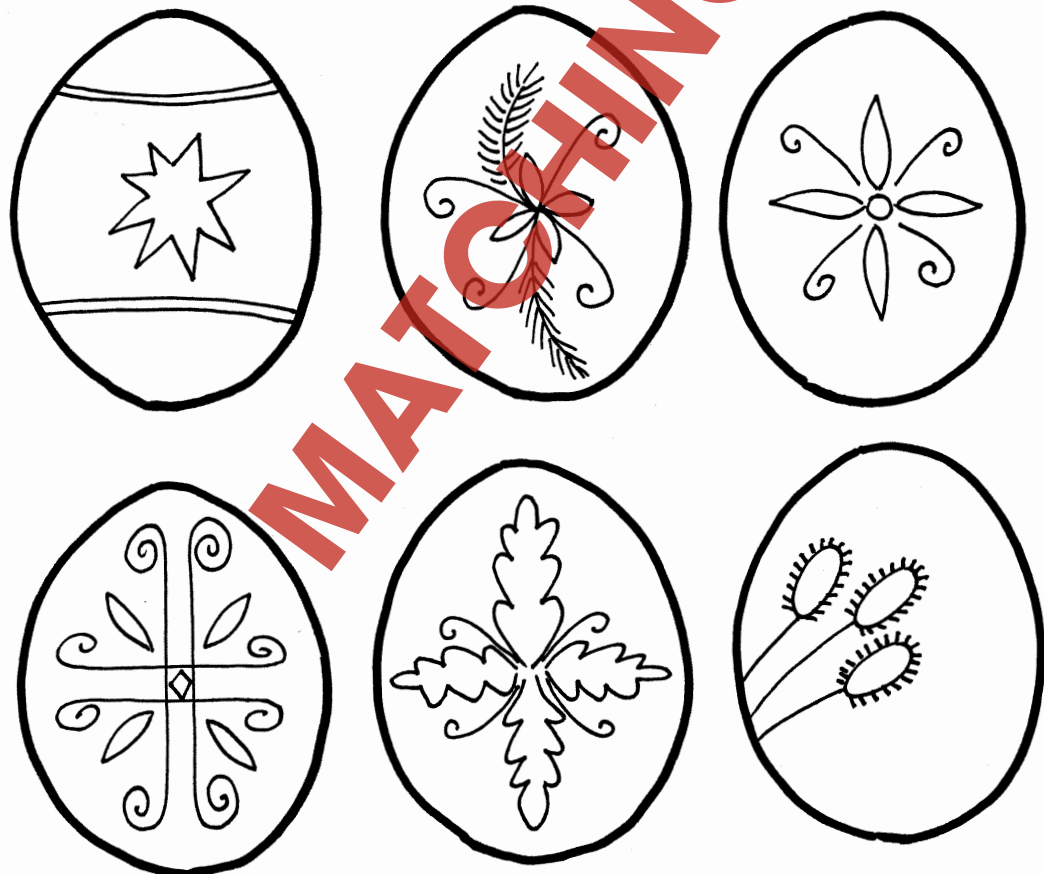
Tell a Story with Stick Puppets!
