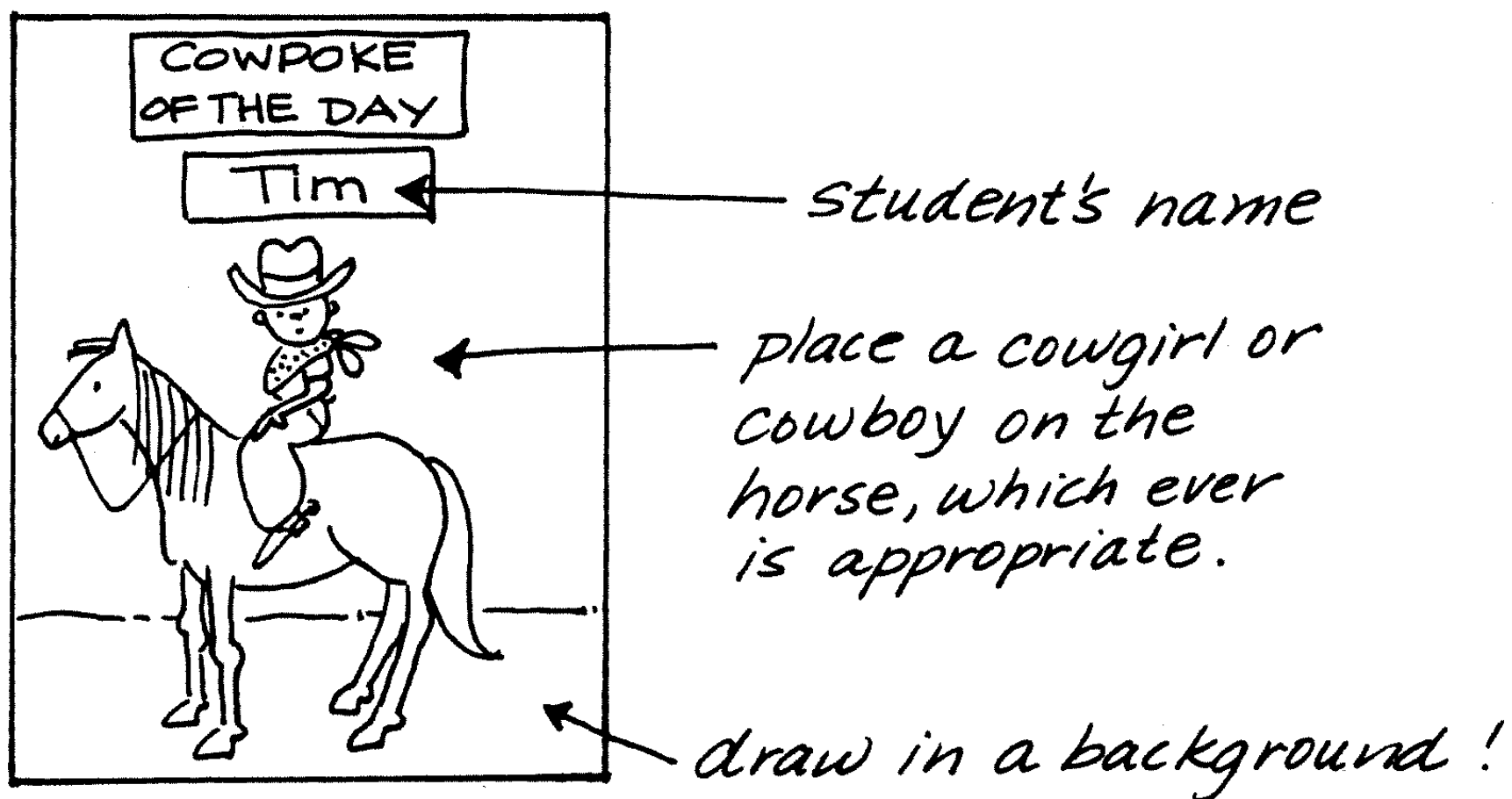
Use the clip art to decorate certificates and newsletters. The clip art is also used in a hands on activity.

PARTS OF A COWBOY

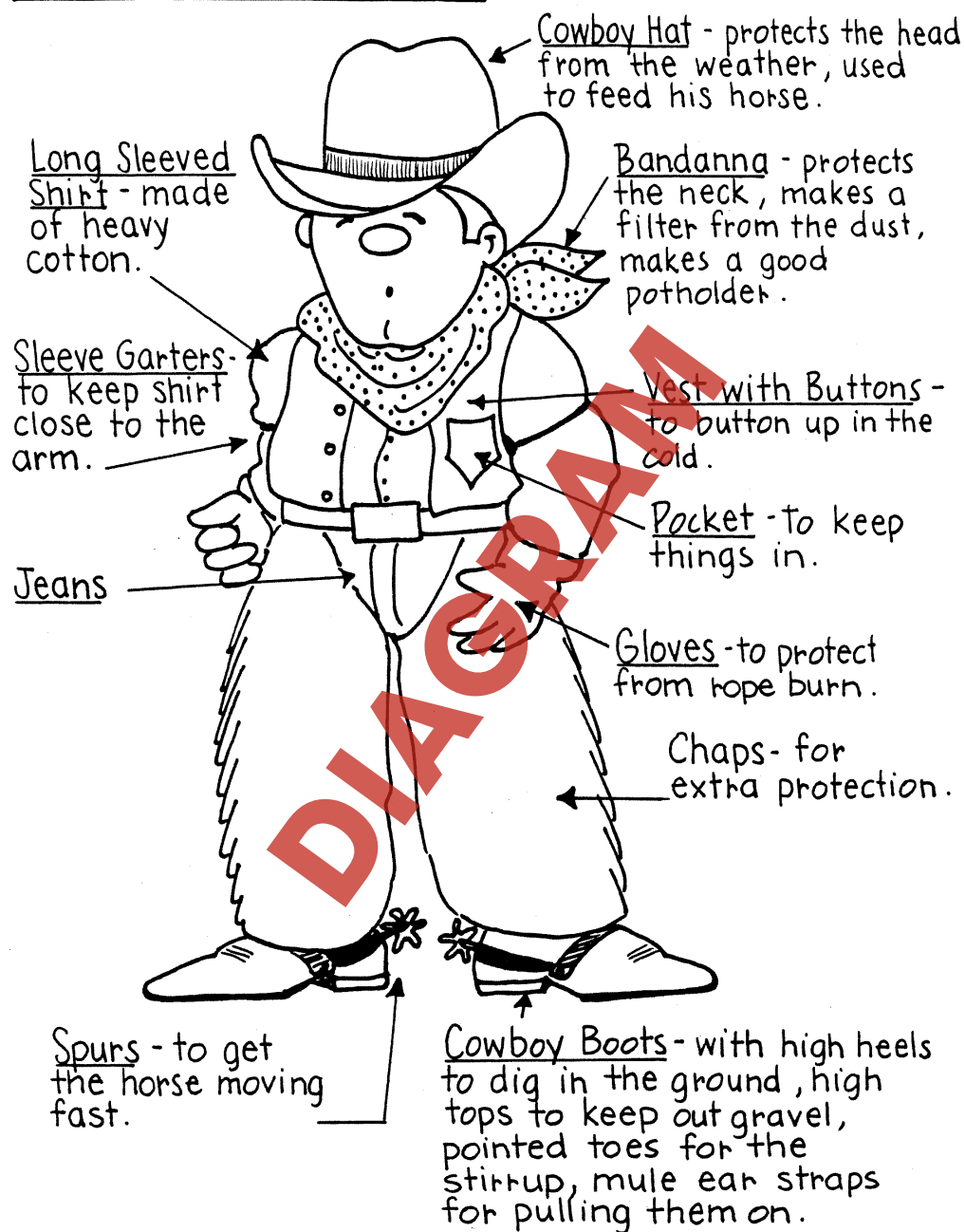
Enlarge to 11 x 17" with your photocopier for a bulletin board display. Students can also include this handout in their cowboy theme books.

sing to the tune of Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star

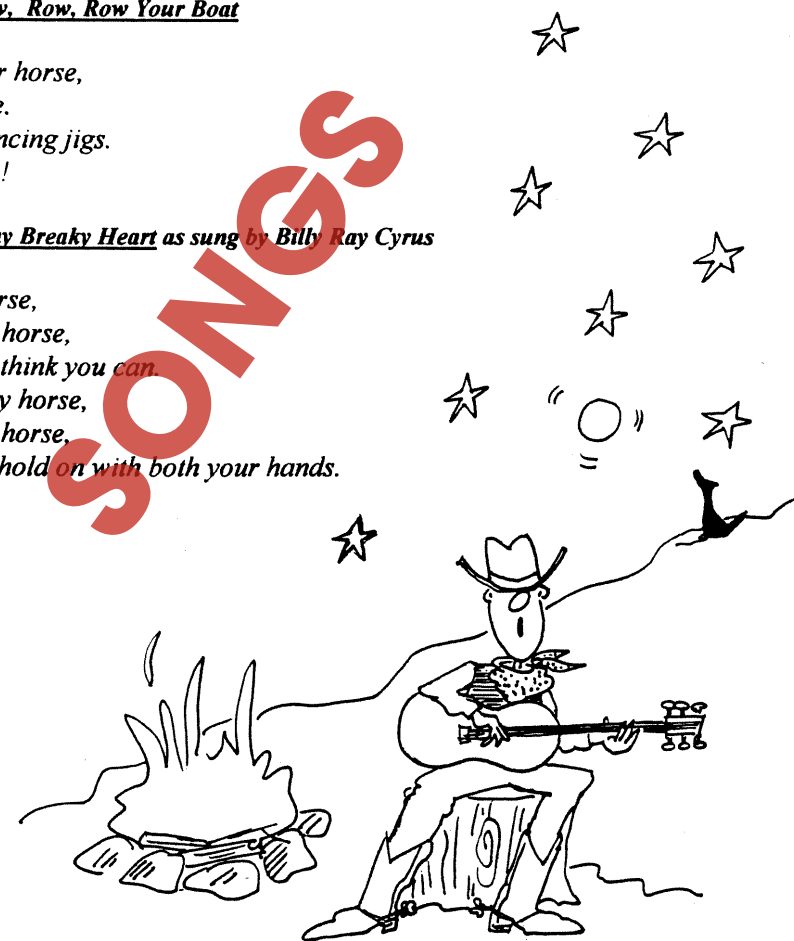
Bronco, bronco, buck away,

sing to the tune of Row, Row, Row Your Boat



Ride, ride, ride your horse,

sing to the tune of Achy Breaky Heart as sung by Billy Ray Cyrus

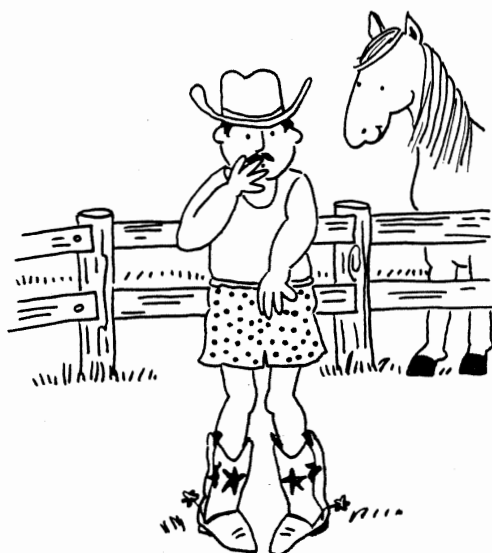

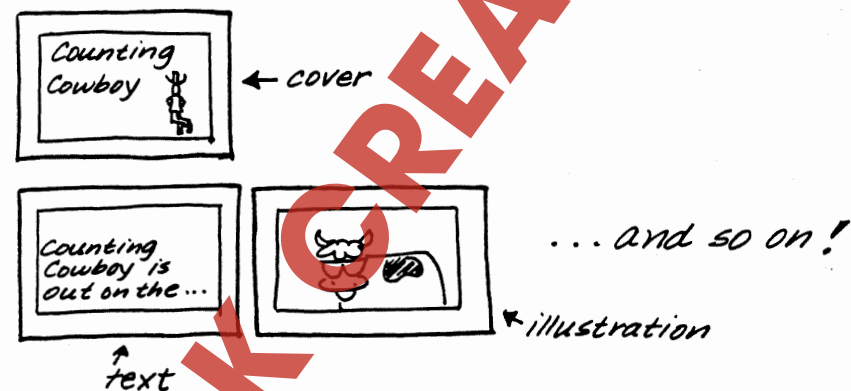
BIG BOOK- Counting Cowboy

Students will count along with Counting Cowboy.

You will need 6 sheets of 2 ply bristol that measures approximately 23x28" or 51 x 76 cm. Any nice bright colour will do, however, avoid neon coloured bristol, as the brightness distracts from the text and illustrations.

Cut each bristol sheet into 4, giving you 6 pages.

Colour the illustrations. Cut out the text and illustrations and assemble as shown:



LITTLE BOOK

SEQUENCING ACTIVITY

Student Objective: To sequence the story pictures and/or the text.
Use the *LITTLE BOOK* to make a hands on sequencing activity. Cut out each cowboy hat page, illustrations and/or text. Laminate and store in a zipclose bag for a sequence activity of the story.

VISUAL DISCRIMINATION COWBOY BOOTS

Student Objective: To find the pairs of cowboy boots.
Make two copies of the *COWBOY BOOTS*. Photocopy onto coloured bind paper and highlight with colour. Cut out the instruction card. Laminate all the pieces. Store in a zipclose bag.

SETS TO NUMERALS

Student Objective: To match sets and numerals.
Photocopy 20 blank cowboy boot patterns from the *STUDENT BOOKMAKING PATTERNS*.
Using your photocopier, reduce the *COWBOY CLIP ART* by 64%. Make 10 copies. Cut out sets of the pictures and glue onto 10 cowboy boots. On the remaining 10 cowboy boots, write the answer sentences.

For example:
I can count 5 pairs of cowboy boots.
I can count 10 cowgirls.
