

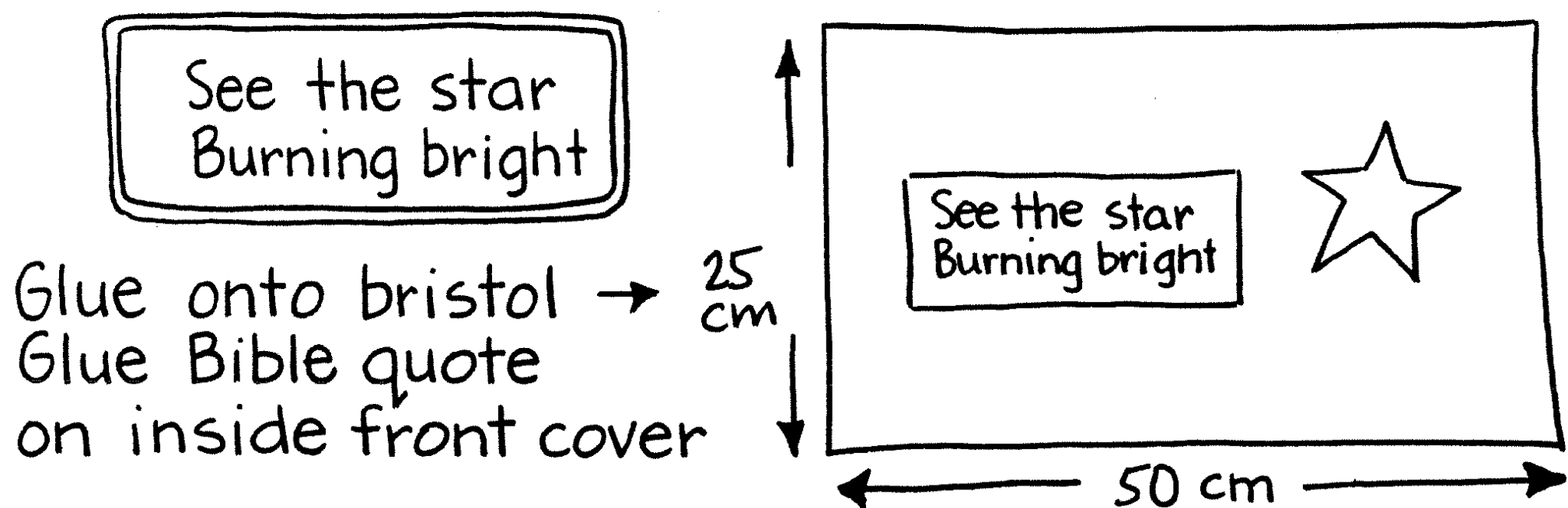
* Big Books for Christmas *

Make Big Books for Christmas the easy way. Just colour and cut out the large bold illustrations. Cut out the text. Glue onto bristol. Add any finishing touches. Laminate and bind. It's easy and the kids will love the stories.

1. A Night Filled with Love

You'll need 7 sheets of 2 ply bristol, approx. 50 cm x 25 cm. Suggested colours: 3 blue, 1 brown, 1 yellow, 1 pink plus colour for cover.

Colour and cut out illustrations. Cut out text and border with wide tip coloured markers.



★ Star stickers, yellow, can be added to the blue bristol pages.

More Ideas

1. Reduce the pages by 50% to make small books for the children to take home.
2. Reduce and make picture cards and sentence cards. Use as a matching activity.

2. Under the Tree

Set up the same as #1 using green bristol for 6 pages and red for the cover.

More Ideas

1. As an art activity, have the children draw what they could give each person in the story. Use the sentence as a paste up or the children can write it.



Make a class book using the illustrations.

2. Reduce and make picture cards and sentence cards. Use as a matching activity.
3. Make a Snowman

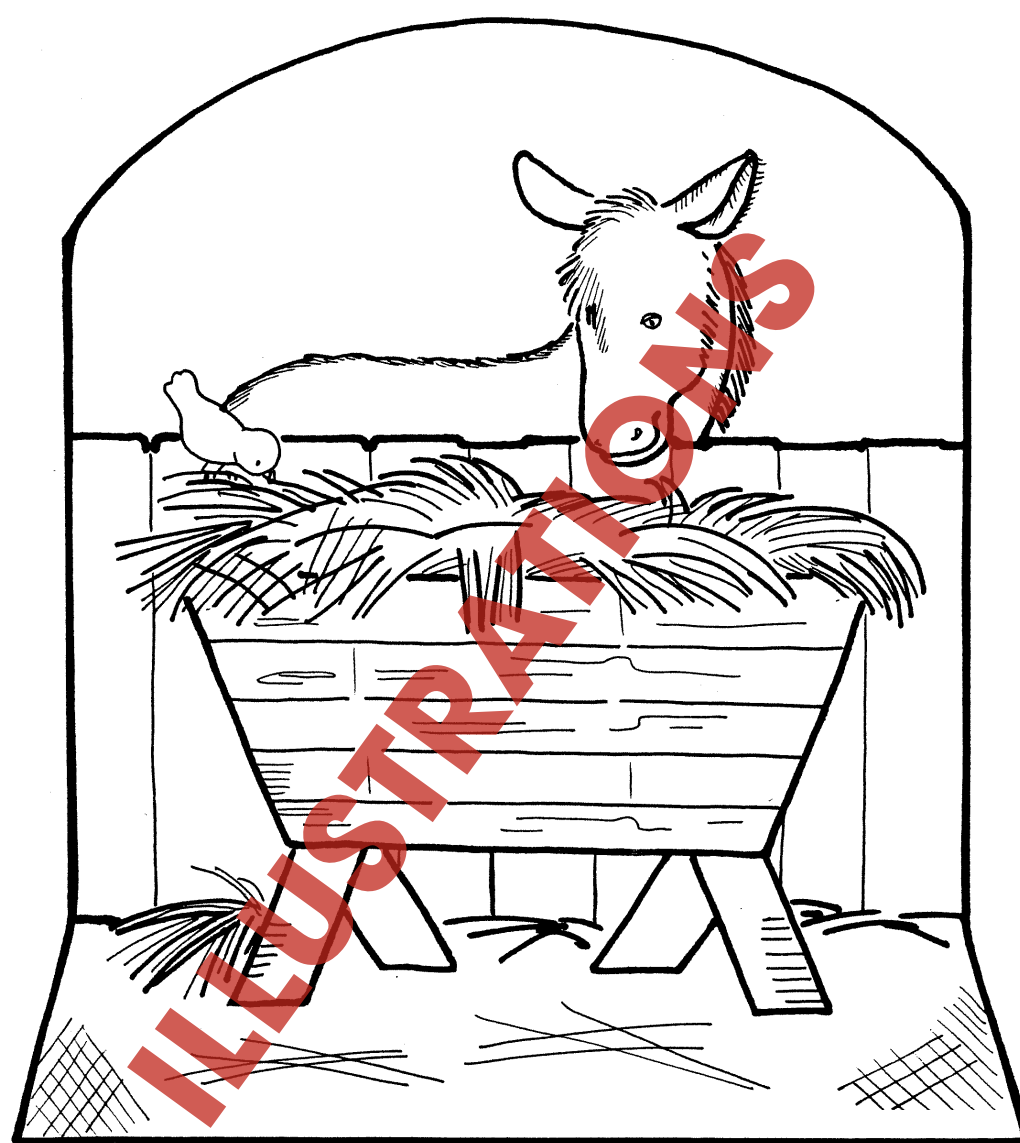
Set up as #1 and #2, using 9 pages of red and a coloured cover.

Use the pictures to make a sequencing activity.

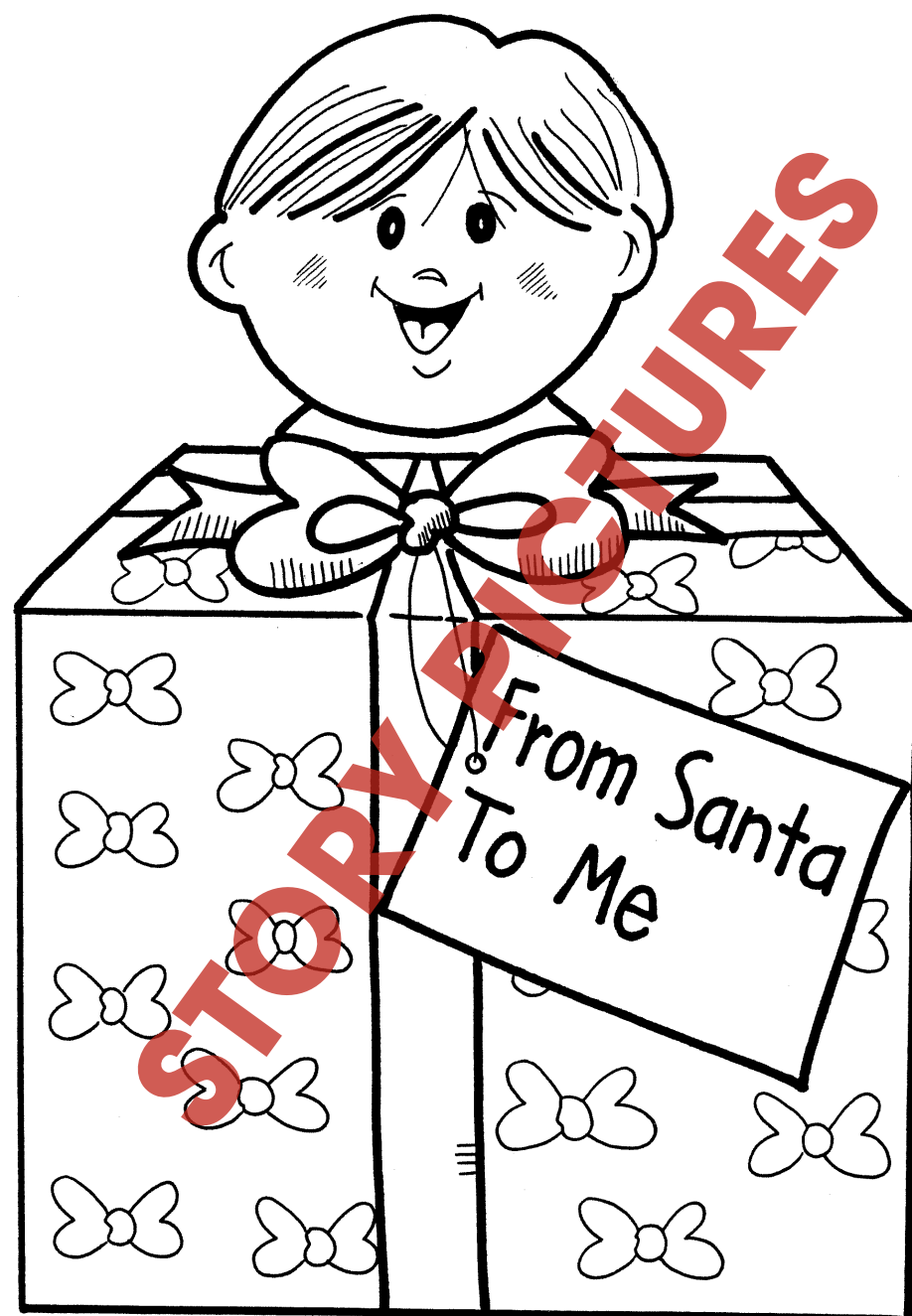


See the star... Blue bristol
