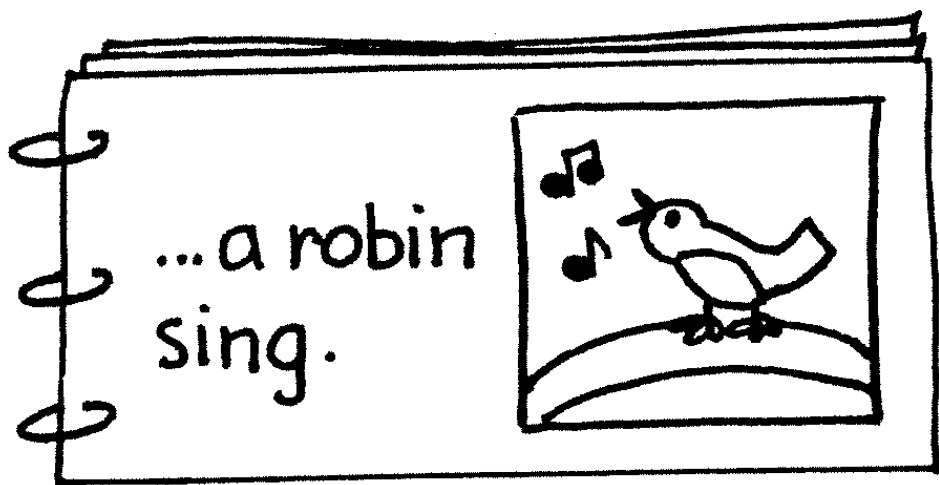


Simply Spring

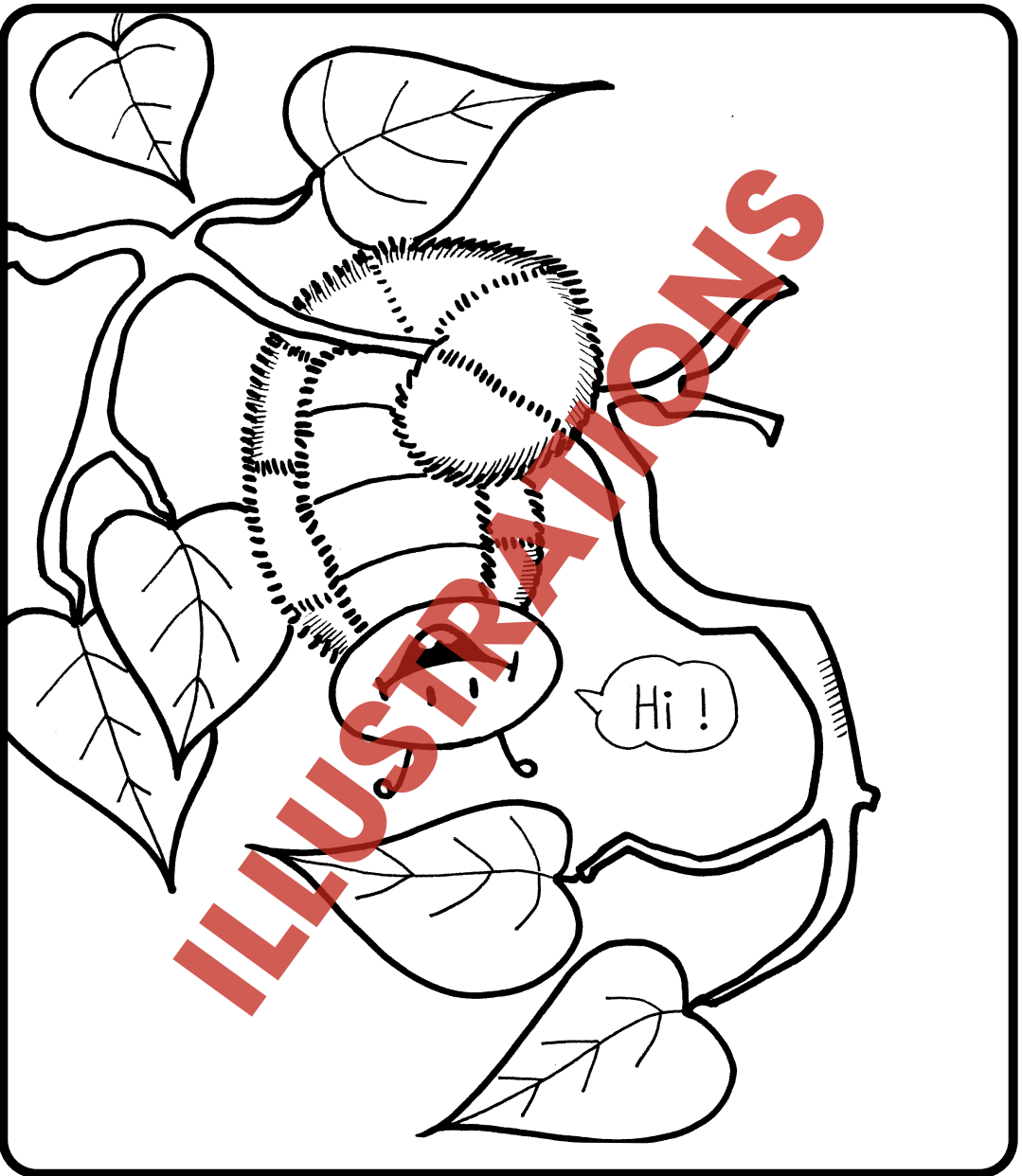


Laminate and bind.

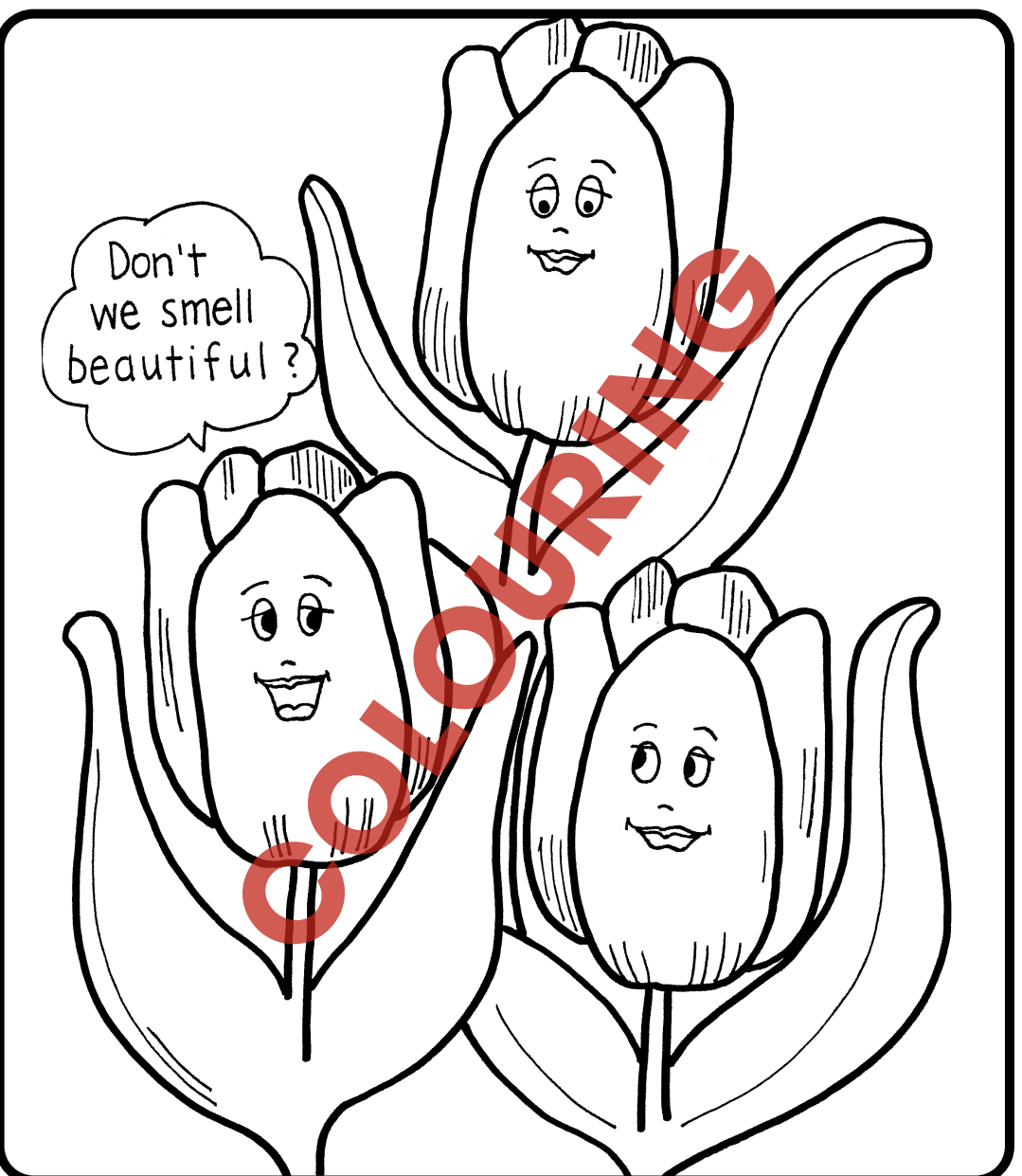
(Borders can be decorated with Spring stickers)

2. List all of the creatures that need water to live.

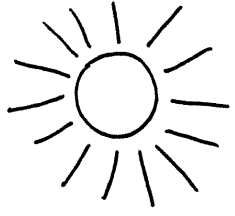


...a robin sing.

Can grow and can live.

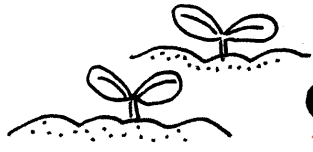

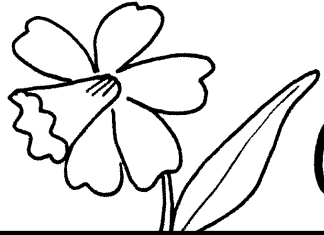
