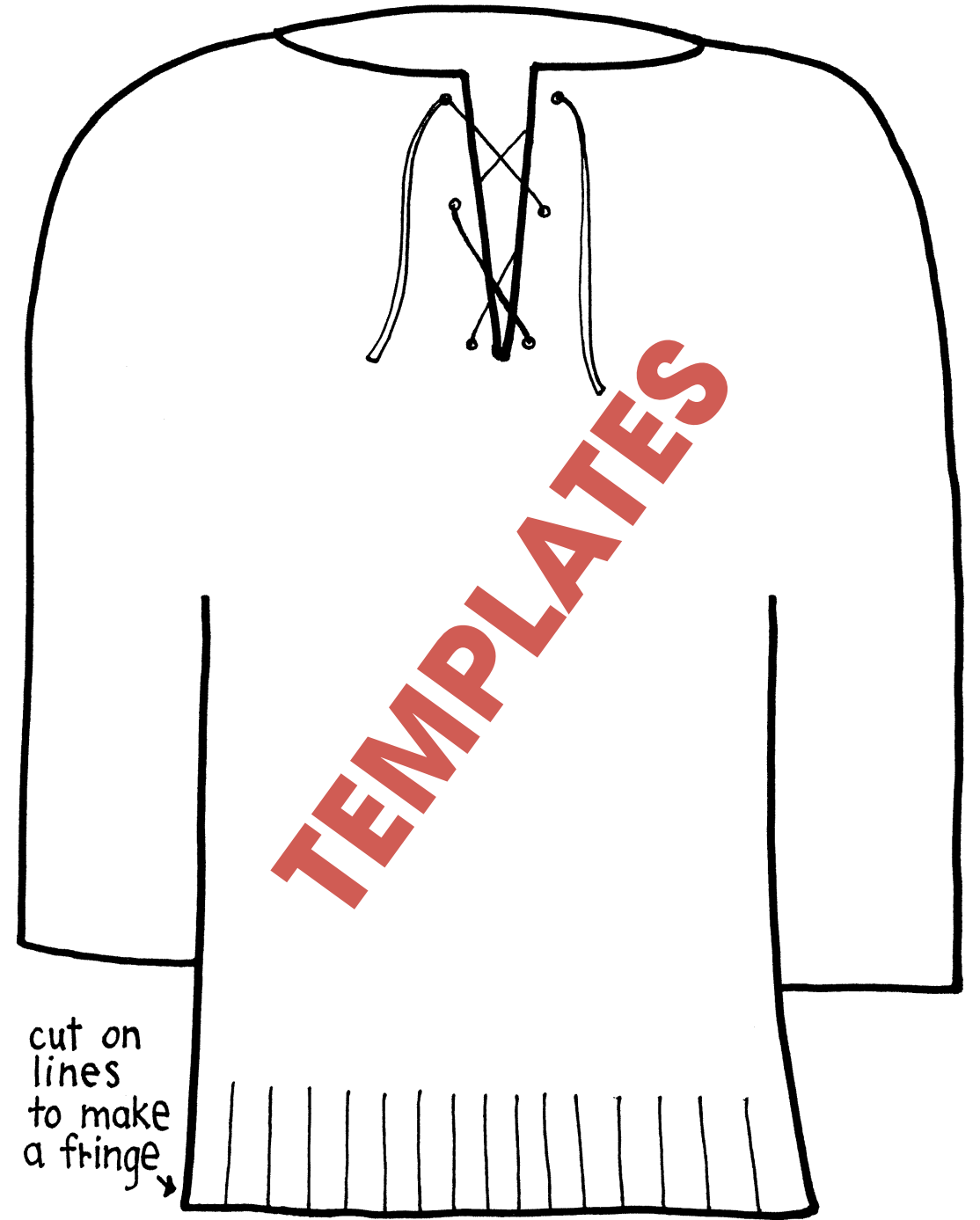

Big Book Assembly

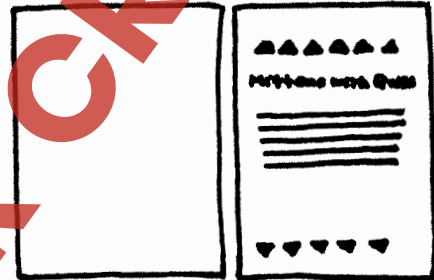
To make your Big Book, you will need 2 sheets of coloured 2 ply bristol board sheets that measure approximately 23x28" or 51x76 cm.

"I will hunt a porcupine. He moves slow!"

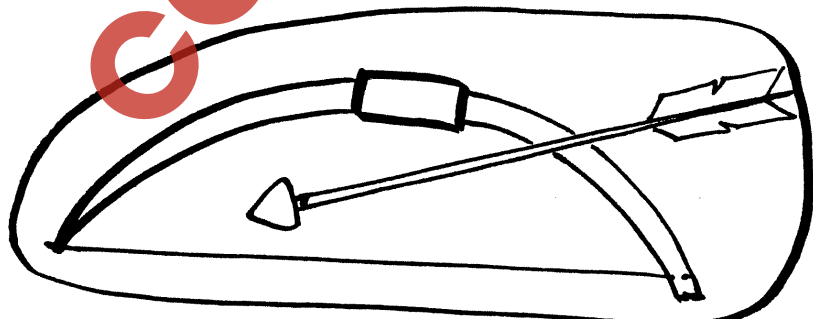
