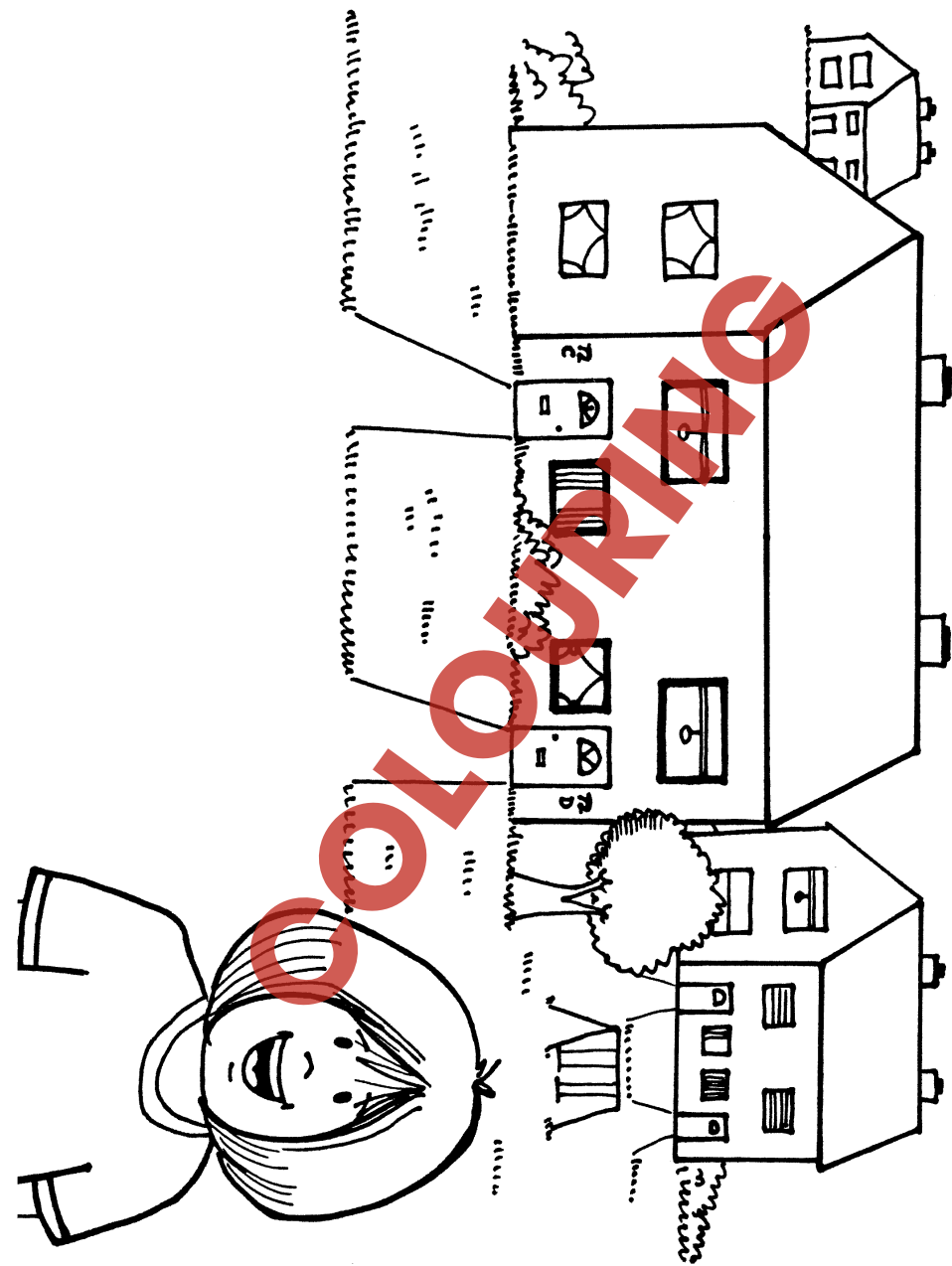


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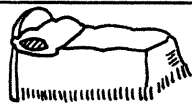

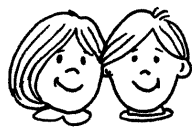

Perogies are made from dough and a filling.

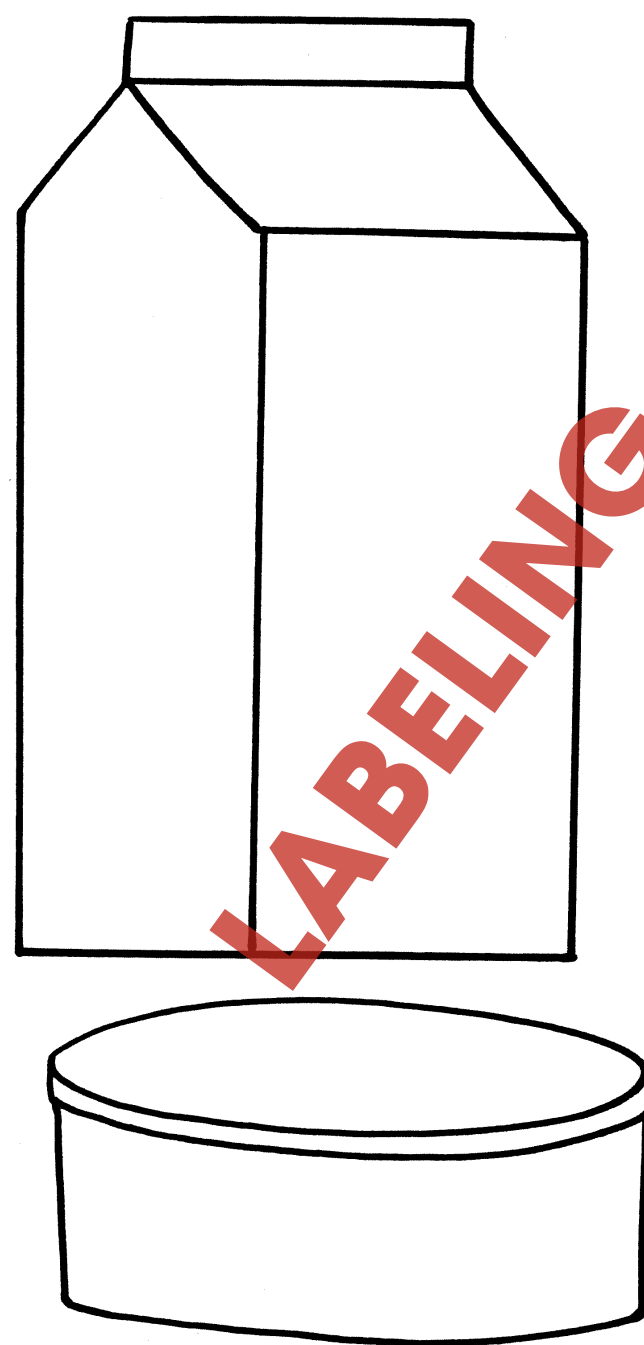
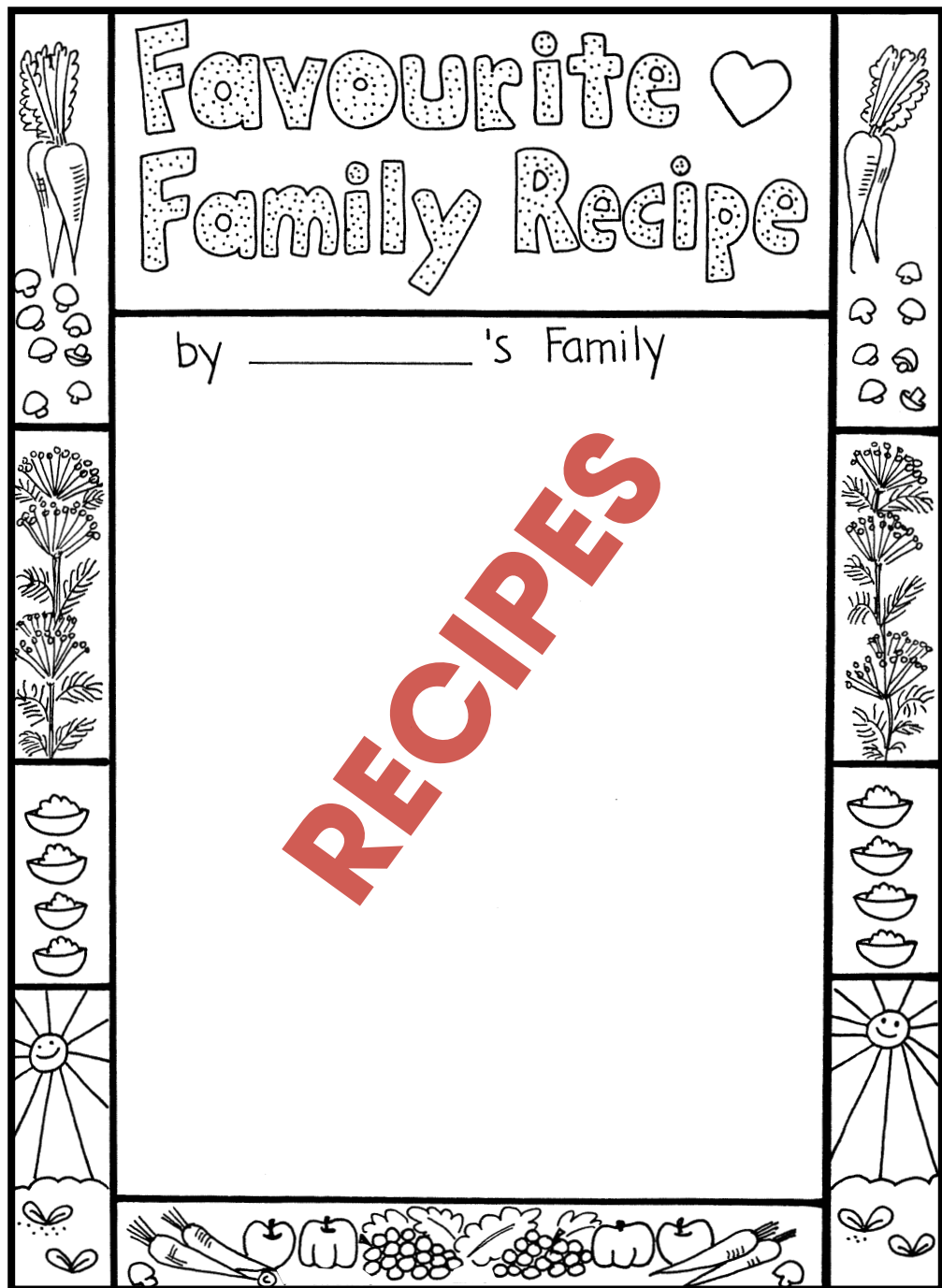
The dough is made from flour, water, salt and melted butter.

The dough is rolled out and cut into small squares.

A small amount of filling is placed in the centre of the square. The square is folded to form a triangle. The open sides are "pinched" together.



The perogies are boiled in water, drained and served with sour cream and bacon bits.
