What do koalas look like?

Koalas are covered with thick fur that is gray on top and a yellowish-white colour underneath. The fur on their stomach and ears is a lighter colour. Koalas have large round noses, small eyes, and big, round, fur-trimmed ears. They have short, stumpy tails. Adult koalas can be 60 centimetres long and weigh up to 14 kilograms. They live for up to 20 years in the wild.


